Program:

Cracow University of Economics

Poland:

Poland is located in Central Europe and shares borders with 7 countries and the Baltic Sea. Cracow, the historic capital of Poland, escaped much of the destruction of World War II and retains its beautiful architecture and historic atmosphere.

Courses:

Students can take courses in Business, Accounting, Economics and a variety of other disciplines. Students must also take a Polish language class. Classes are taught in English. Course listings are available on the Isabella Cannon Centre website. Grades earned count toward an Elon GPA.

Dates/ Applications:

Spring program - Early February to end of June

Year program - Late September to end of June

Because the Polish academic year follows a different schedule than the U.S., Fall only study abroad is **not** available. Students must complete the Elon University Study Abroad Application by the published deadline. Initial approval is granted by Elon and final acceptance is granted by Cracow University of Economics. Applications are accepted one semester in advance.

Housing:

Students live with other international students in flats around the city, choosing whether to live alone or with roommates. Placements are done by a realtor in-country, selected and approved by the University.

Eligibility:

A minimum 3.0 GPA and sophomore, junior or senior status is required. No Polish language experience is required.
