Dear School Guidance Counselor,

Enclosed are applications for the Burlington Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. Gladys Outlaw Gallop Scholarship. Two \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded. The applications may be copied if additional copies are needed.

This scholarship is open to all students who meet the scholarship guidelines. The student must:

- Be a US citizen
- Be a legal NC resident
- Be an Alamance County high school senior
- Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher on an unweighed scale of 4.0
- Be involved in school and community activities
- Have plans to enroll full-time at an accredited four-year university or college the fall immediately following graduation. The university/college must be a public or private, not for profit institution from which the applicant can receive his/her bachelor's degree.

Each applicant is required to write a 500 word essay detailing his/her future aspirations and must secure two letters of reference: one explaining school extracurricular and volunteer service activities; the other explaining community and volunteer service activities.

Applications are to be postmarked on or before March 31, 2010.

GLADYS OUTLAW GALLOP SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria for Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be a legal North Carolina resident
- Be an Alamance County high school senior
- Be Male or Female
- Possess a GPA of 2.5 or higher on an unweighed scale of 4.0
- Be involved in school and community activities
- Have plans to enroll full-time at an accredited four-year college or university the fall following graduation

The college or university must be a public or private, not for profit institution, from which you can receive your bachelor's degree.

Spouses, children, parents and siblings of members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., are ineligible to apply.

Description of Funds

The recipient will receive a one-time \$1,000.00 scholarship to be applied to college or university expenses. A check will be mailed from the chapter after receiving a request and a letter of acceptance from the college or university you will be attending.

Application Guidelines and Procedures

- Type or print, in black ink, the entire application form and attach a recent photograph.
- Obtain an official high school transcript that includes your first semester senior year grades and copies of your best ACT/SAT test scores.
- Write a 500 word essay detailing your future aspirations (see essay criteria on last page).
- Secure two letters of reference.
 - One letter should explain your school extracurricular and volunteer service activities.
 - One letter should explain your community and volunteer service activities.
 - Only one letter of reference may be from a teacher, counselor or administrator.
 - Each letter should include the name and position of the person providing the recommendation.
 - Letters should be submitted in a sealed envelope and must be signed across the flap by the writer of the letter.
 - A signed statement confirming that the applicant has read and understands the guidelines and procedures of this scholarship.
