

Below is a list to get you started on pre-requisites for OT graduate programs. It is important for you to look at schools and determine requirements because they are different across schools with some commonalities. AOTA (<http://www.aota.org/default.aspx>) has great information about OT and you can find links to different programs. There is limited information on what most schools want, but this gives you an idea.

Common Course Requirements:

- 2 semesters General Biology (w/ lab) (*BIO 111/113 and BIO 245/246*)
- 1 or 2 semesters Physics
- Human Anatomy (w/ lab)
- Human Physiology (w/ lab)
- General Psychology
- Abnormal Psychology
- Developmental Psychology
- Statistics
- Intro to Anthropology/Sociology
- Lifespan Development
- Medical Terminology

Additional Course Requirements or Common Recommendations:

- Exercise Physiology/Kinesiology
- Physics
- Algebra
- Ethics/Philosophy (Humanities)
- English/Literature
- Research Methods
- Chemistry

Other Common Requirements:

- Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores
- Recommendation letters (one from OT)
- Significant volunteer work in patient care
- Minimum GPA 3.0
