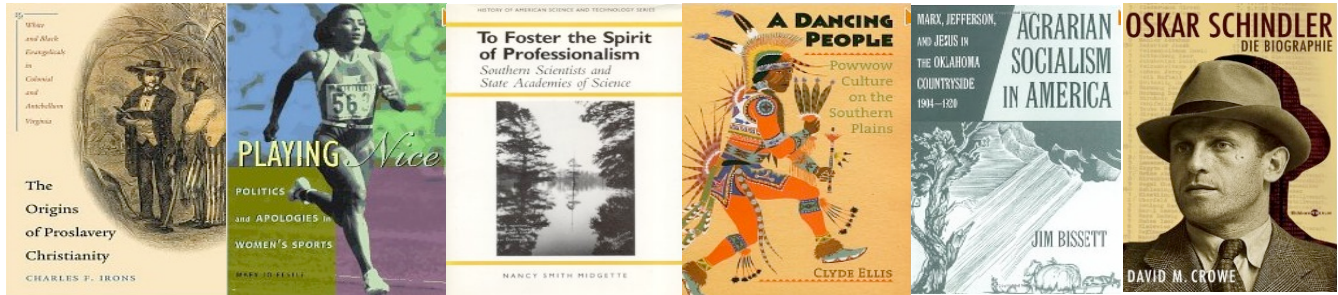

A Distinguished Faculty with a National Reputation

From 2008-10, our department's faculty has received 100 percent of the university's full-year sabbaticals and 67 percent of the institution's Senior Faculty Research Fellow Awards. Among our full professors, 71 percent have been the recipients of the university's highest honors for research, teaching or service, and many have been recognized nationally and internationally for the same. One hundred percent of our full-time, permanent Africa experts have been awarded titles as honorary chiefs by communities on the continent.

... as Scholar-Mentors

- **Primary authors of two dozen published or contracted books in English and foreign languages** on topics ranging from the Holocaust, Roma (Gypsies), and Oscar Schindler to European imperialism in Africa, and U.S. history and culture, including: Southern culture, southern scientists, race relations in southern churches, history of a southern institute of higher education, Alamance County, N.C., loyalists in North Carolina, the history of women in sports, agrarian socialism, and Native American education, hymns, dances and powwow culture.
- **Recipients of major national-level awards** and/or grant reviewers for competitive awards from the Department of Education, National Endowment for the Humanities, Fulbright, Rockefeller Foundation, Social Science Research Council, National Science Foundation, Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, College Board and other sources.
- **Mentors of more than two dozen published student authors and co-authors** of peer-reviewed journal articles, scholarly magazine articles, encyclopedia entries and book reviews, co-presenters of scholarly papers at regional, national, and international conferences, and applicants seeking national and international fellowships and awards.
- **Visiting faculty and invited speakers at the finest institutions**, including Columbia, Duke, Dartmouth, Notre Dame, Mount Holyoke College, University of Virginia, West Point, the British Museum and Southeast University (China).
- **Professionals active in scholarly communities** as conference organizers, expert witnesses, guest speakers on radio and television, and editors and manuscript reviewers of national and international journals.

... in Study Travel/Study Abroad

- **80 percent of our full-time, permanent faculty regularly lead study travel courses and 20 percent are foreign born**, offering students first-hand opportunities to learn the history, geography and culture of Britain, Germany, China, Honduras, Costa Rica, Ghana, Greece and Italy from faculty who speak foreign languages and have lived overseas.

... in Interdisciplinary Studies and Premier Campus Programs

- **100 percent of our full-time faculty serve** or served as coordinators, directors, chairs, advisors, or mentors for student organizations, inter-disciplinary majors and minors (African/African-American Studies, International Studies, GIS, Classical Studies, Leadership, Women's & Gender Studies), committees (Academic Council, Promotion & Tenure), and premier programs (Honors, Periclean Scholars, Elon College Fellows, Lumen Scholars, Undergraduate Research, Faculty Research & Development, General Studies, Center for Teaching & Learning).
