The timing of this camp is outstanding for most of you beginning preparations for your upcoming seasons; many of you are looking to boost your stock with college coaches—this is the camp to help you do so. The All-Skills format will emphasize evaluation and should be an outstanding opportunity for players to be identified. While evaluation is the emphasis, it is important to our staff that every camper leaves camp having learned something that will make himself a better player. With the staff lined up for this camp, we strongly believe this will happen.

Mike Kennedy

Coach Kennedy is entering his thirteenth year as Head Coach at Elon University. Coach Kennedy is entering his thirteenth year as Head Coach at Elon University. In 2008, Kennedy guided the Phoenix to its 10th straight year of 30+ wins with a record of 44-18. The Phoenix claimed their second Southern Conference championship in the last 3 years and also won the Southern Conference tournament for the first time in program history. The Phoenix also claimed the programs third regional appearance as a #3 seed in the Cary, NC regional. f He led the Phoenix to its first Southern Conference Championship and its second Division I Regional (at large bid) in 2006 where Elon picked up its first ever regional win with a 5-4 win over Mississippi State. The 2006 Phoenix won a school record 45 games. In 2006, the Phoenix posted wins over #14 South Carolina, #28 College of Charleston, and two victories over SEC foe Auburn. Kennedy also guided the Phoenix to its first ever national ranking by Baseball America when the Phoenix came in at # 25 in the polls. Elon finished the season with a final RPI ranking of 24th. Kennedy also played 3 years professionally in the Oakland A's organization following his career at Elon.

Greg Starbuck

Starbuck is in his eleventh year as assistant coach and second as associate head coach at Elon. Starbuck is in charge of infielders, hitters, and serves as the Phoenix recruiting coordinator. His responsibilities also include working with the Phoenix players on base running and coaching third base. Starbuck has been instrumental in helping build Elon's program as one of the best in the state of North Carolina.

Robbie Huffstetler

Huffstetler is in his sixth year on the Phoenix staff after coaching two prior seasons at Southern Conference foe Appalachian State. Huffstetler's responsibilities include working with the Phoenix outfielders, assisting with hitters, and infielders. Huffstetler also has 4 years of summer coaching experience within the Coastal Plains League and The Northwoods League. In 2005, he led the Mankato Moondogs to a team record 34 wins.
