Whether it be **pitching, catching, hitting, or any combination** of the three, **we can make you better.**

### **Pitching**

Improve and enhance the mechanics necessary to become an effective pitcher. Learn and take part in drills geared towards improving overall pitching skills. Gain an understanding of how to increase speed and have control of the fastball. Instruction on the change-up will also be included along with several different grips and styles. Each player will walk away from the clinic with a concrete understanding of pitching fundamentals and what she needs to do in her own time to become a great pitcher.

### **Catching**

Learn the proper defensive techniques of the catching position. Catchers will receive instruction on stance, blocking balls, throwing to bases, pop-ups, signal calling and knowledge of the strike zone rules.

### **Hitting**

Become an effective fastpitch hitter through proper mechanics. The art of hitting will be taught from both a mental and physical standpoint. Multiple drills will be introduced to help learn and perfect the swing. Players will have a chance to practice proper hitting techniques through various drills, including t-work, soft toss, hitting machines. Bunting and slapping techniques will also be included.

## **Registration**

Bat (if they have one), glove, and catchers gear if attending the catchers' clinic. No cleats allowed indoors, please bring indoor shoes as well as cleats.

Wear proper clothing for the weather— sweatpants, sweatshirt, and any additional warm clothing. Be prepared for cool temperatures. Indoor shoes and cleats may be necessary in the event of rain.

The softball field is located on East College Ave., across from the East Gym on the Elon campus.

Take a right at stop light which is Haggard Ave. Go through campus and take a right on Antioch Ave. Take a left on East College. Park in the East Gym parking lot across from the softball field.
