Official Visit Refresher

Recreational Activities

During an official or unofficial visit, a prospective Student-athlete may participate in recreational activities in a facility that is not open to the general public (e.g., facility reserved for student-athletes to participate in voluntary activities), provided:

- 1) Such activities are not organized or observed by members of the athletics department coaching staff (including strength and conditioning coaches) AND
- 2) Are not designed to test the athletics abilities of the prospect.

Complimentary Tickets

Generally, a prospect on an official visit may receive only three (3) complimentary admissions. However... if a prospect is a member of a nontraditional family, the institution may provide up to two (2) additional complimentary admissions to the prospect in order to accommodate the parents accompanying the prospect to attend a home athletics event per NCAA Bylaw 16.6.7.2.1.

Transportation Expenses

Transportation expenses covered by an institution for a prospect and prospect's parents or legal guardians during an official visit may include the following:

- Round Trip air transportation (for prospect only)
- Mileage rate if using automobile transportation
- Automobile transportation accompanied by institution's coach (for prospect only), or,
- Ground transportation between the campus and any bus station, train station, or airport.
