Individuals who work at a Campus Compact member institution in Florida, Kentucky, North Carolina, and Virginia are eligible to apply for a scholarship to cover the \$75 registration fee to attend this event. Recipients are responsible for all additional expenses related to attending, including travel, and lodging.

Expectations of Scholarship Recipients

If selected for an award, applicants must confirm their ability to attend the event. Recipients are expected to fully engage in the activities and to be willing to be included in any photos or media. Scholarship winners also will be expected to provide a follow-up summary to their state office discussing their experiences and sharing what they learned.

These are the components of the application.

- Provide contact & demographic information
- Answer the following questions:
 - Why are you interested in attending this conference?
 - How will participation support your career and learning objectives?
 - How will you apply what you learn to your community college?
- Verification: Applicants must verify that they are willing to fulfill the expectations.
- Upload your resume.

The review committee will select three individuals per state with a financial need whom they believe are most likely to leverage the opportunity. They will seek candidates who are eager to learn and plan to apply the skills and knowledge gained to benefit their institution and their communities. New community engagement professionals are encouraged to apply.

All applicants will be notified of results via email by May 27.
