Buildings:

1. **Nades:** Colonnades Dining Hall
2. **KBC/KOBC:** Koury Business Center
3. **Club Belk:** Belk Library
4. **HBB:** Hook, Brannock, and Barney (residential buildings)
5. **Loy Center:** Greek houses
6. **Harden Club House:** Building by the intramural fields
7. **Billy House:** Honors Pavilion
8. **Whitley:** Location for various speakers and events on campus located behind Carlton and Alamance
9. **Academic Village:** The pavilions (honors, international, political sci etc...)
10. **McEwen Dining/ McEwen Communication Building:** Although both of these buildings have the same name, they are for two different purposes

Food Locations/ Food Lingo:

11. **Octagon:** Food court in Moseley Center
12. **Phoenix Cash:** Money that you deposit onto you Phoenix card that can be used on campus and at certain off campus locations (you can deposit money at the Phoenix card office or online through Blackboard); Phoenix cash works similarly to a debit card
13. **Meal Dollars:** An allotment of money that is on your phoenix card that comes with the meal plans and can be used to buy on campus food
14. **Acorn:** Coffee and sandwich shop near McEwen Communication building
15. **PanGeos:** Wrap, salad, and pasta place in Moseley Center in front of Octagon (now offering made to order omelets in the morning!)

Specific places/rooms:

16. **Boney Fountain:** Fountain by the entrance to Moseley Center located near the visitor parking lot
17. **Fireside/Hearth Lounge:** The area with an electric fireplace, couches, and tables in Moseley Center right outside of Octagon
18. **LaRose Digital Theatre:** Small lecture theatre on the first floor of Koury Business Center
19. **Young Commons:** Lawn in front of Moseley (between Koury Athletics and Library)
20. **Isabella Cannon Room:** Small room in the performing arts building where various events or speakers will take place
21. **Amphitheatre:** The concrete outdoor theatre in the academic village in front of Lindner Hall
22. **McCrary vs. Yeager vs. Black Box Theatre:** McCrary is the larger auditorium in the performing arts building and Yeager is right next to it but is much smaller and the Black Box is a very small intimate venue for dance recitals
23. **Inman Reading Room:** A quiet room for studying on the first floor of Linder Hall.

Road Names/Transportation:

24. **Williamson Ave.:** Road that has Acorn on it, the Pendulum office, the performing arts center, etc...
25. **Haggard Ave.:** Main road that splits campus between Moseley Student Center and Alamance
26. **BioBus:** The buses that transport students to various on and off campus locations

27. **Fake Break:** The mini break from school between winter term and spring semester
