

# Freshman Elections Quick Guide

## All Candidates:

- Sign and Date Candidacy Statement
- Attend elections information meeting on **Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 at 6pm (Moseley 217).**
- **All Completed Election Applications and Candidate Speeches are due at 5:00pm Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 in the SGA Office (Moseley 221A). Late Applications will not be accepted!**
- Campaigning may begin **ONLY** on September 2<sup>nd</sup> **AFTER** information meeting and application packet has been turned in.
- Flyers must be approved by the Elections Committee and Office of Student Development (Moseley 206) prior to being hung.
  - Because of the limited timeframe for approval we encourage you to bring flyers to the information meeting for approval by the Elections Committee and Office of Student Development.
  - Also be prepared to fill out a university sidewalk chalking form.
- A maximum of 75 dollars may be spent on any campaign. Copies of all receipts must be submitted to the Election Committee by **5:00pm Monday September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010 in the SGA Office (Moseley 221 A).**

## Class Officers

All candidates running for class officer positions (President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary) are required to obtain **75** student signatures to be placed on the ballot. These are due at **5:00pm Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 in the SGA Office (Moseley 221 A)**

## Class Senator

All candidates running for the 4 class senator positions are required to obtain **50** student signatures to be placed on the ballot. These are due at **5:00pm Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 in the SGA Office (Moseley 221 A)**
