



**A BILL TO AMEND THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION
CONSTITUTION**


- WHEREAS:** The Student Government Association Constitution does not reference upholding the pledges made in the oath of office as requirements for holding office, and;
- WHEREAS:** The Student Government Association Constitution does not adequately outline Organization Council elections, which have been reformatted along with the creation of Organization Council Roundtable Meetings, and;
- WHEREAS:** The Student Government Association Constitution requires the Executive Treasurer to present a revised Treasurers Manual to the Senate at the last Senate meeting of the school year, in addition to closing out all organization budgets within the same time frame, and;
- WHEREAS:** The Student Government Association Constitution states that in the event that the Judicial Committee Chair is accused of a judicial infraction, the SGA Vice President shall appoint a member of the Judicial Committee to serve as Chair, giving that person a significant influence in their own judicial proceedings, and;
- WHEREAS:** The Student Government Association Constitution has several inconsistencies and grammatical errors;


