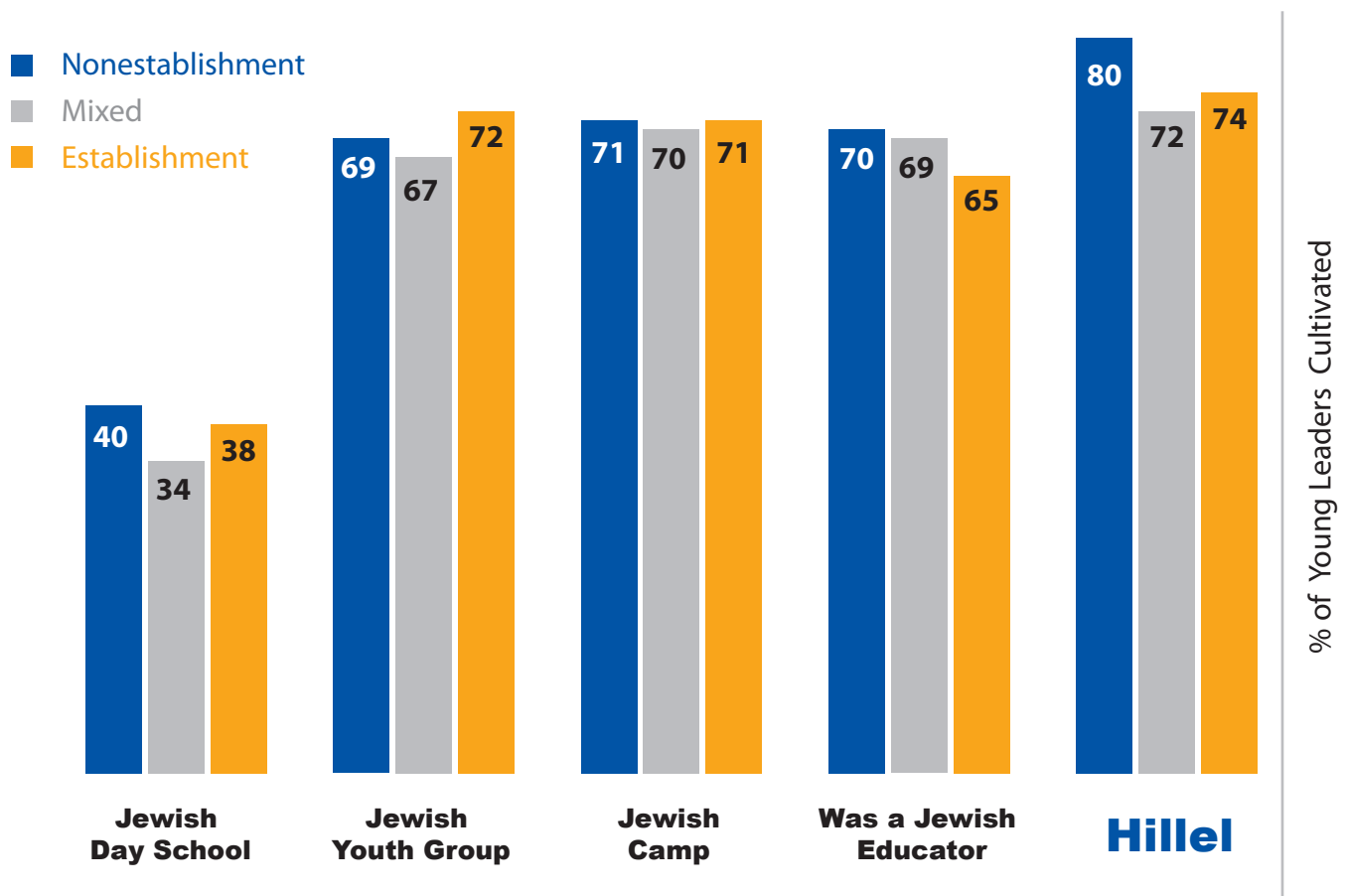


Hillel: Building the Jewish Leaders of Tomorrow

Hillel Background Greatest Predictor of Future Leadership Among Young Jews

An AVI CHAI Foundation study of Jewish organization leaders in their 20s and 30s found that Hillel involvement was the greatest predictor of future leadership, outpacing other shared Jewish experiences. Led by well-known sociologist Jack Wertheimer, the study looked at three types of organizations: Establishment (i.e., mainstays), Non-Establishment (i.e., startups) and Mixed. In each type, Hillel involvement was more common than other experiences among young leaders.
