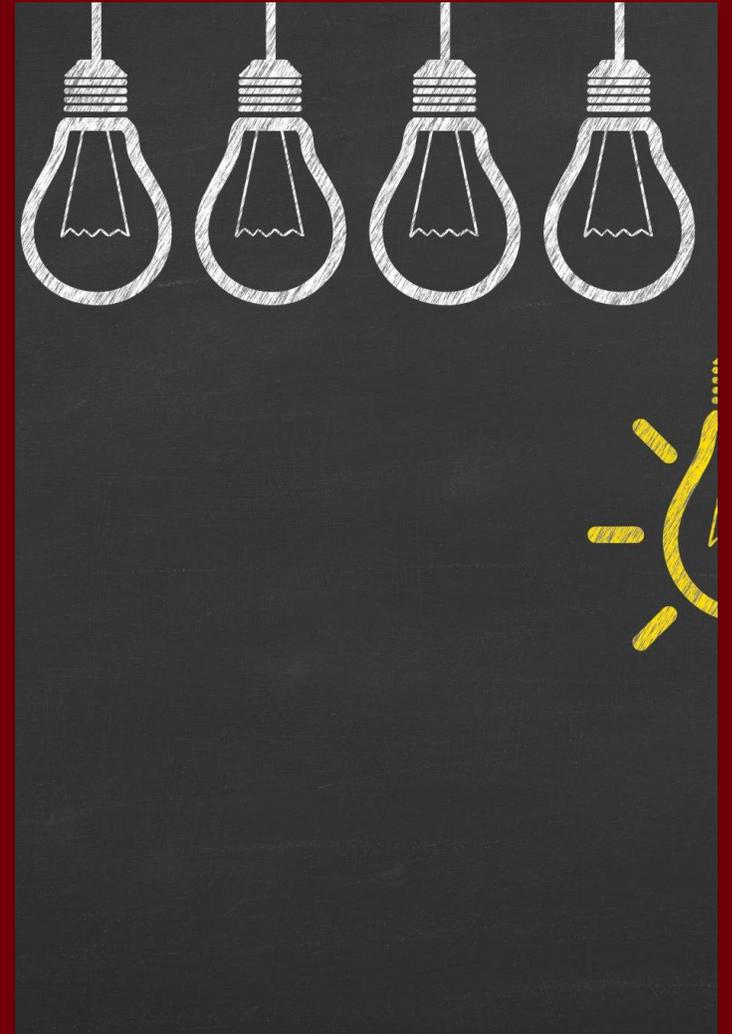

- Describe what a student can demonstrate upon completing an experience
- Represent knowledge, skills, behaviors, and attitudes

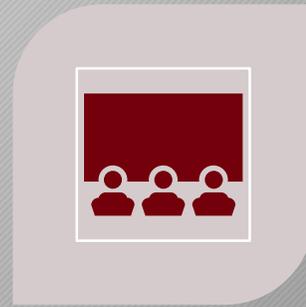

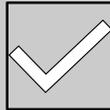

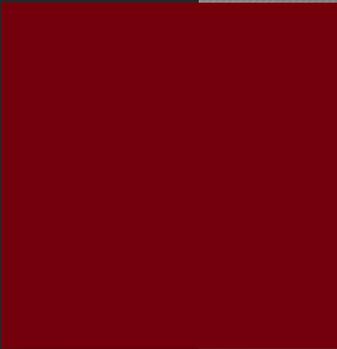

Plan for Student Learning Assessment (PSLA)

- Program Mission Statement
- Intended Learning Outcomes
- Course/Outcome Map
- **Outcome Reporting Schedule**

The outcome reporting schedule describes which outcomes are reported in a given year.

All outcomes must be reporting on in an ongoing basis so that within a reasonable timeframe (~5 years) all outcomes have been measured at least once.

Considered to be closing the loop on the assessment cycle

- Address the status of planned changes
- If the outcome has been remeasured indicate the effect on student performance
- If the outcome has not been remeasured indicate when this will happen

Identify the task/assignment used as evidence of student achievement relative to the outcome

- Describe which students will complete the task.
- Describe the context for the task (e.g., in/out of class)
- Describe your scoring strategy
- Attach assignment and scoring tool if you are using one

Present a brief summary of student performance.

Can be quantitative or qualitative
No identifiable information

- Who participated in the discussion?
- What will you do?
- When will you implement changes?
- Resources needed to implement changes
