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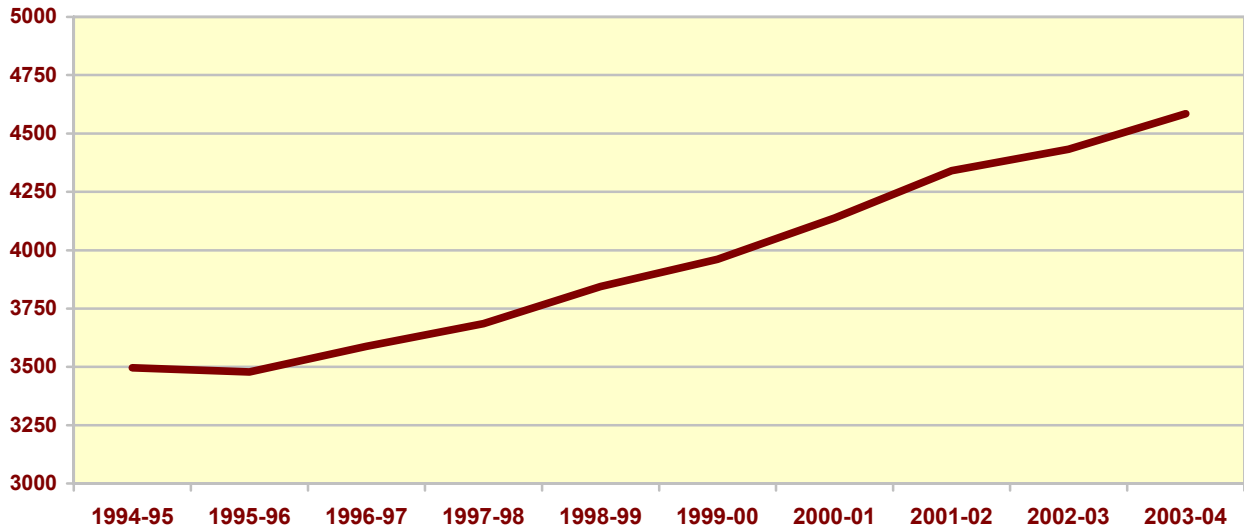

*Total Enrollment*

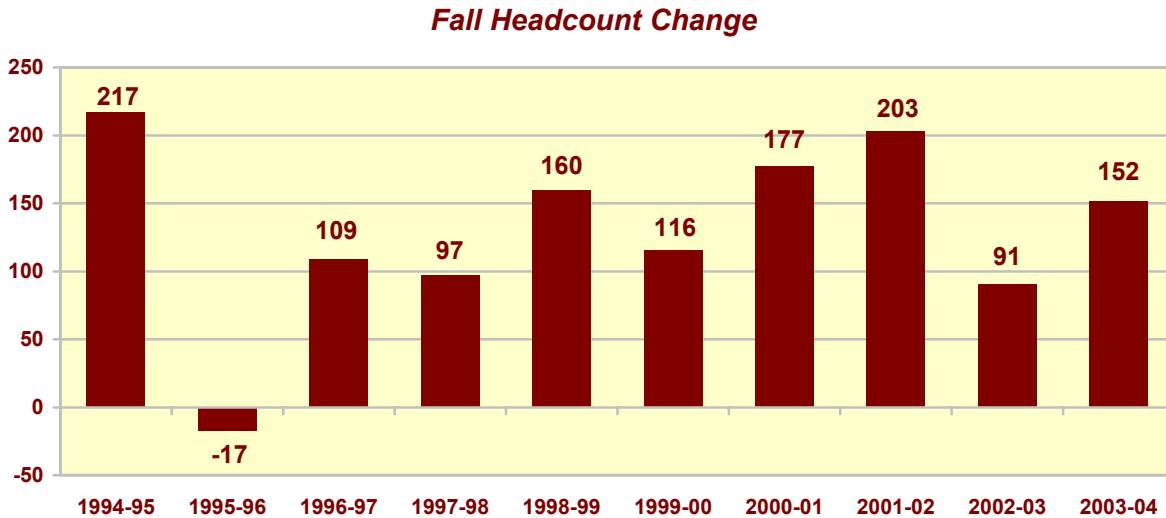

## Fall Headcount Change

The student headcount rose by 152 in 2003-04. Over the past decade, the year-to-year headcount change decreased only once (-17 in 1995-96). Since 1994, total headcount has increased by 31%.



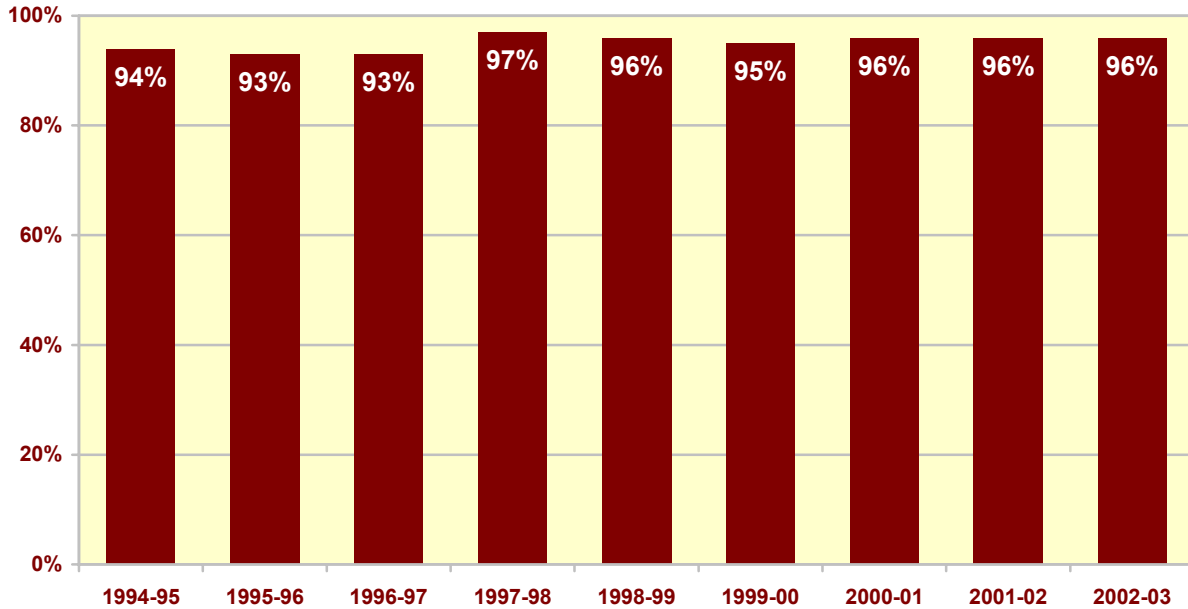

## Fall & Spring FTE

The number of fall FTE students rose to 4,462 in 2003-04. The FTE has risen for twelve consecutive years. The graph below indicates spring FTE as a percent to fall FTE. This ratio has a positive correlation to institutional retention, which indicates the higher this ratio, typically the higher the retention rate.

*FTE: Spring to Fall Ratio*



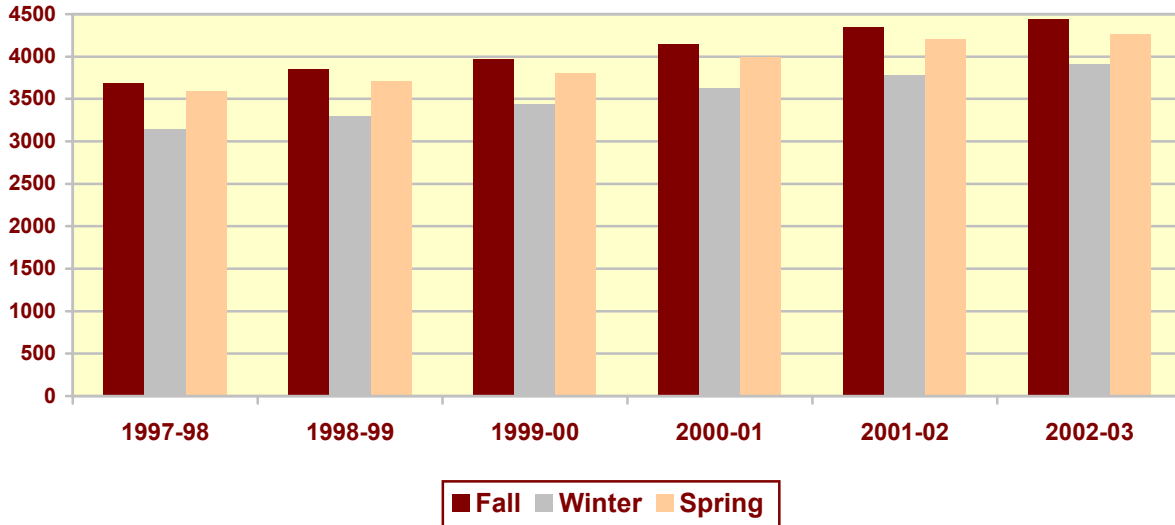

## Fall, Winter & Spring Enrollment

Historically, fall enrollment is higher than spring which is higher than winter. Spring as a ratio of fall is an indicator of retention. The closer this ratio is to 100%, the higher the retention rate.

*Fall, Winter & Spring Enrollment*

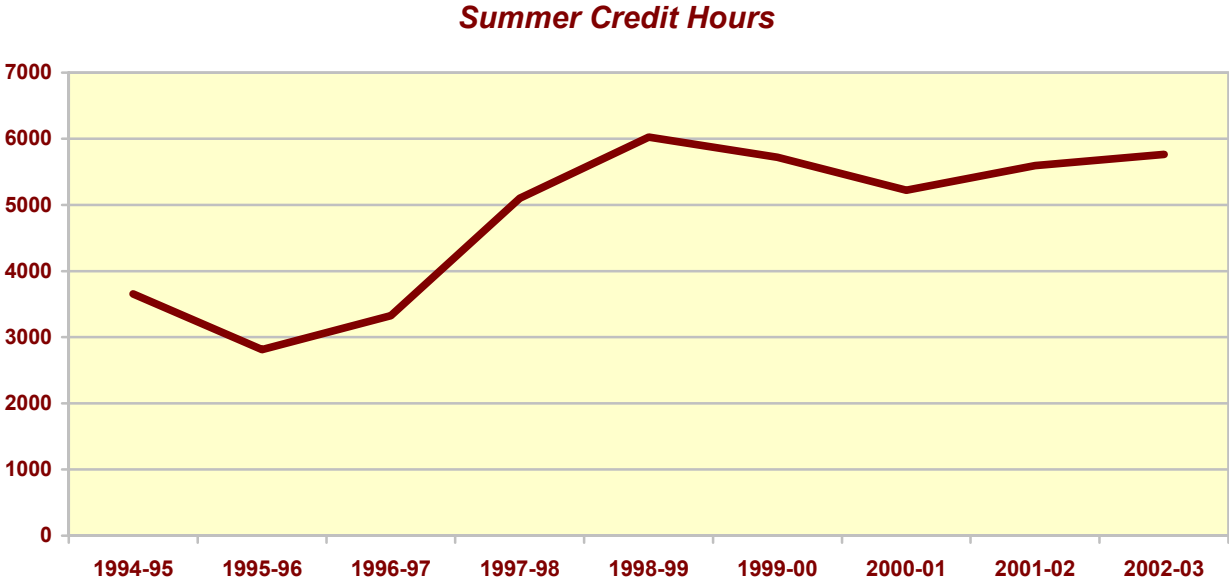

In summer of 2002-03 credit hours generated increased by 170 to total 5,762.



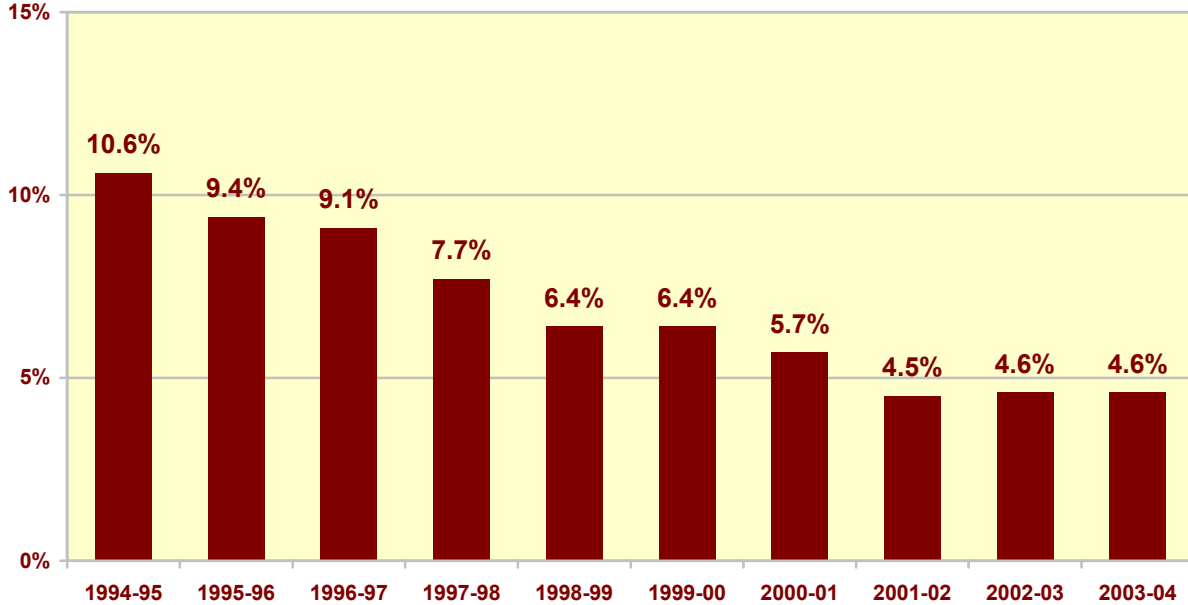

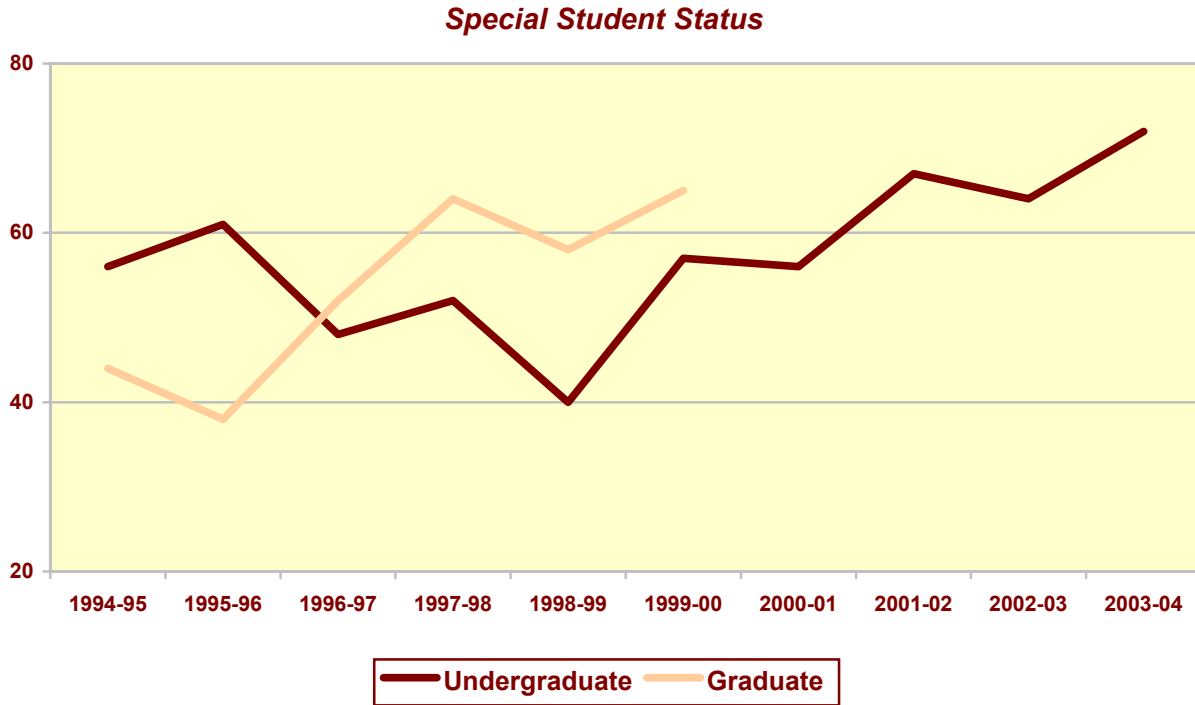

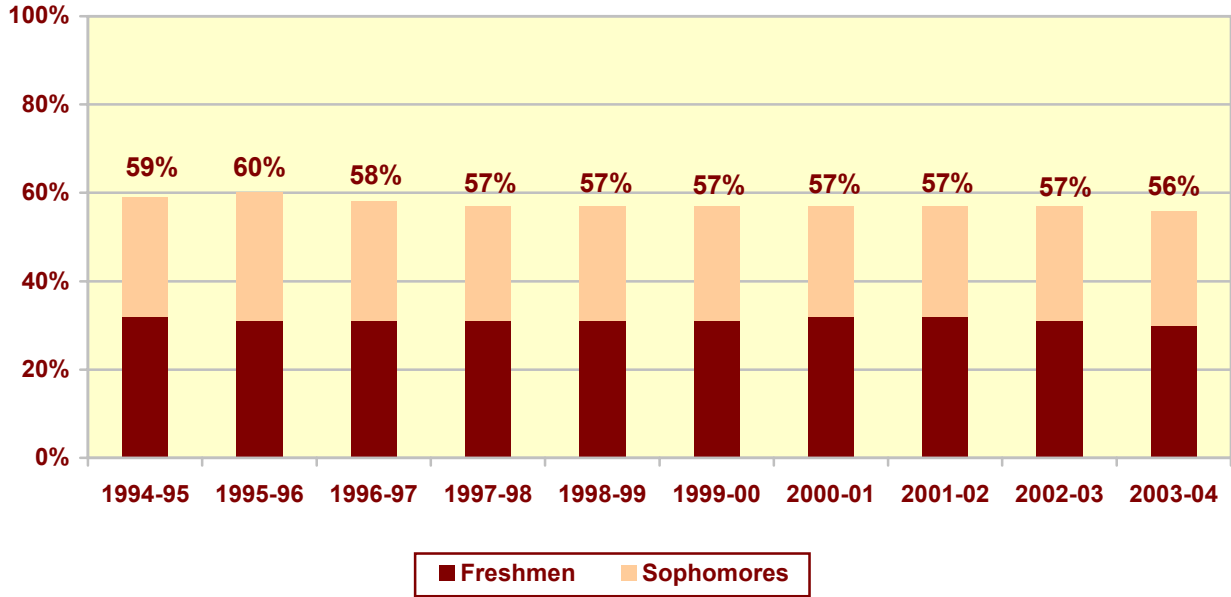

*Freshman & Sophomore Ratio*



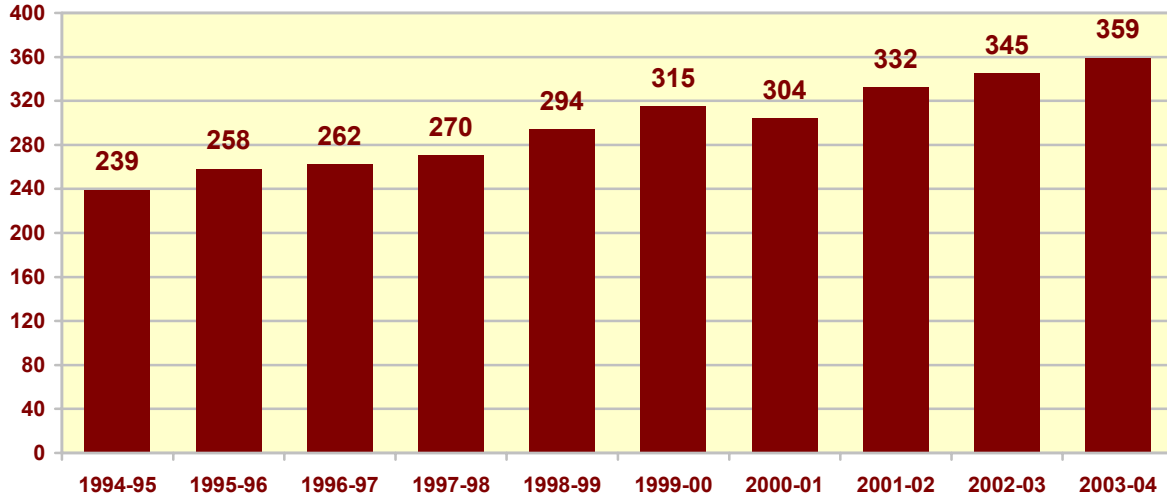

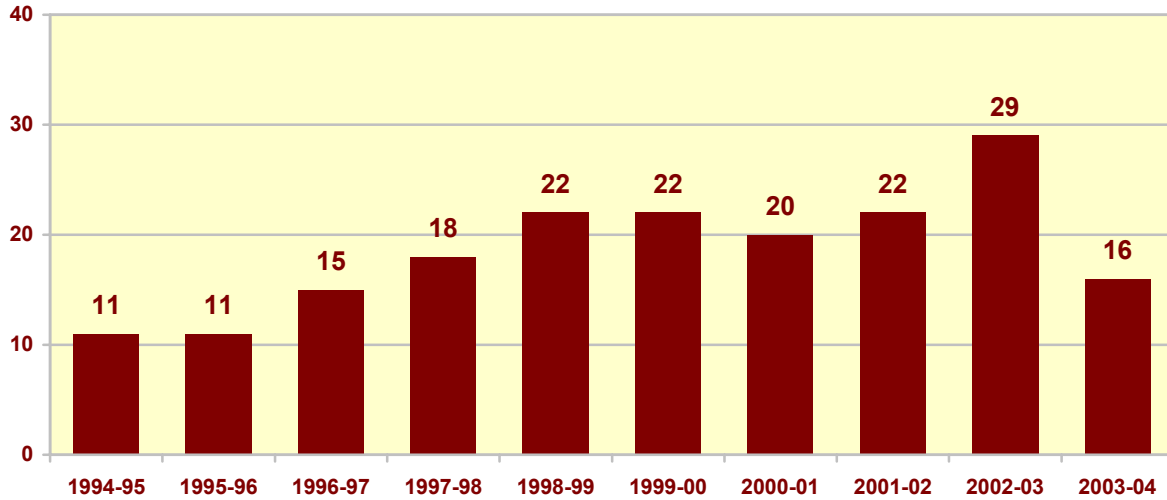

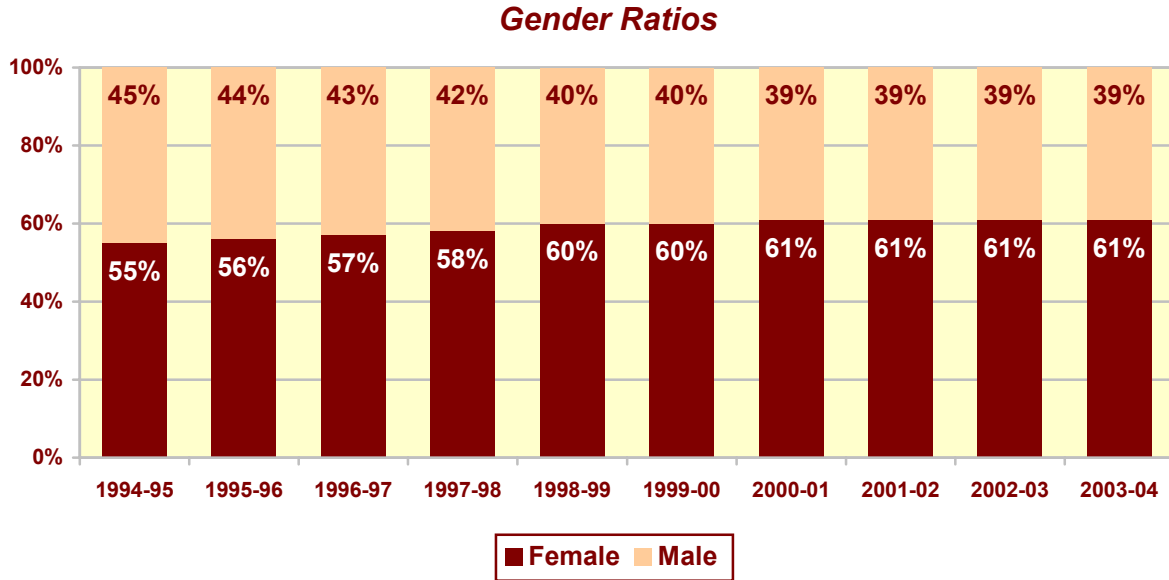

For the fourth consecutive year gender composition remained at 61% female and 39% male.



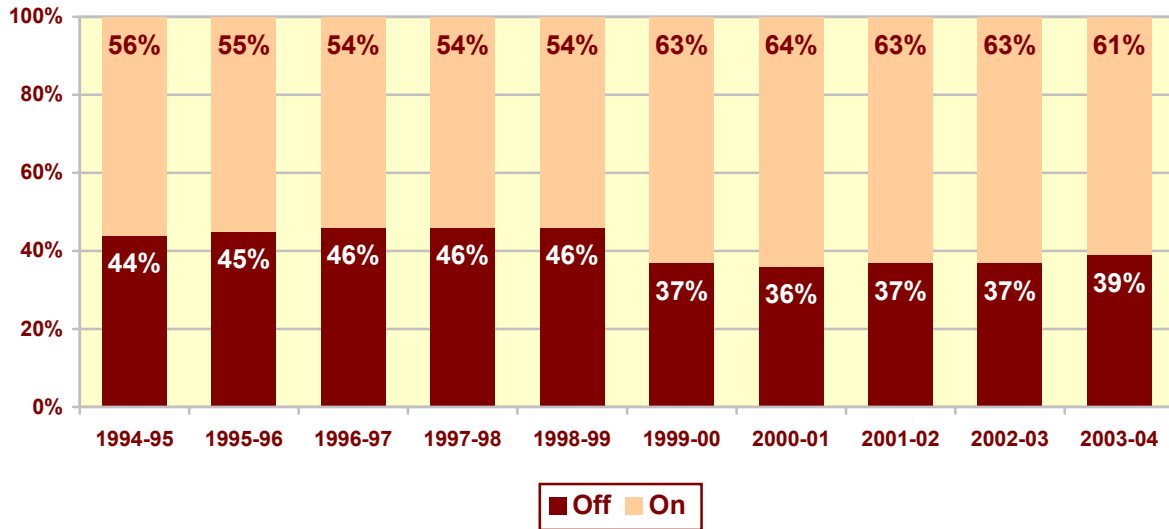

*Undergraduates Living On/Off Campus*



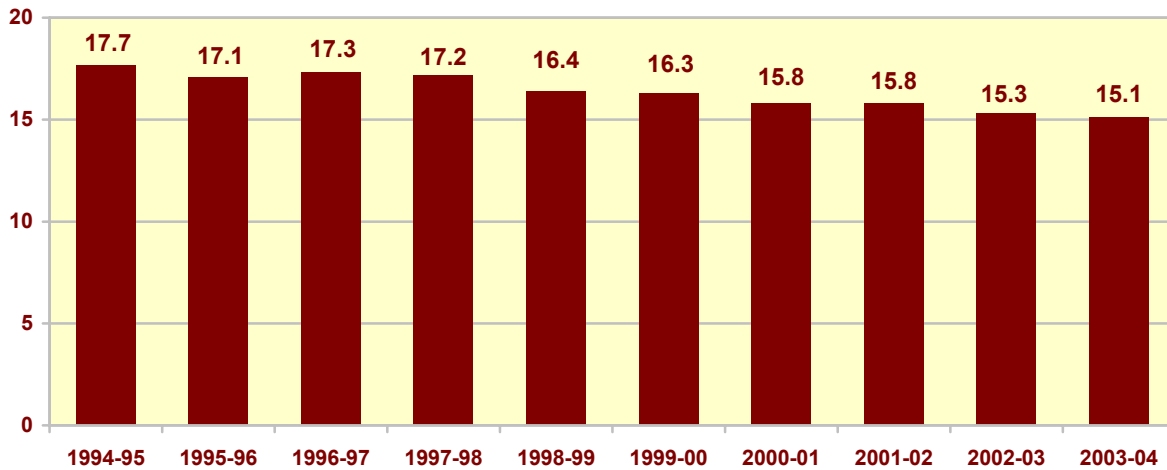

*FTE Students:1 FTE Faculty*



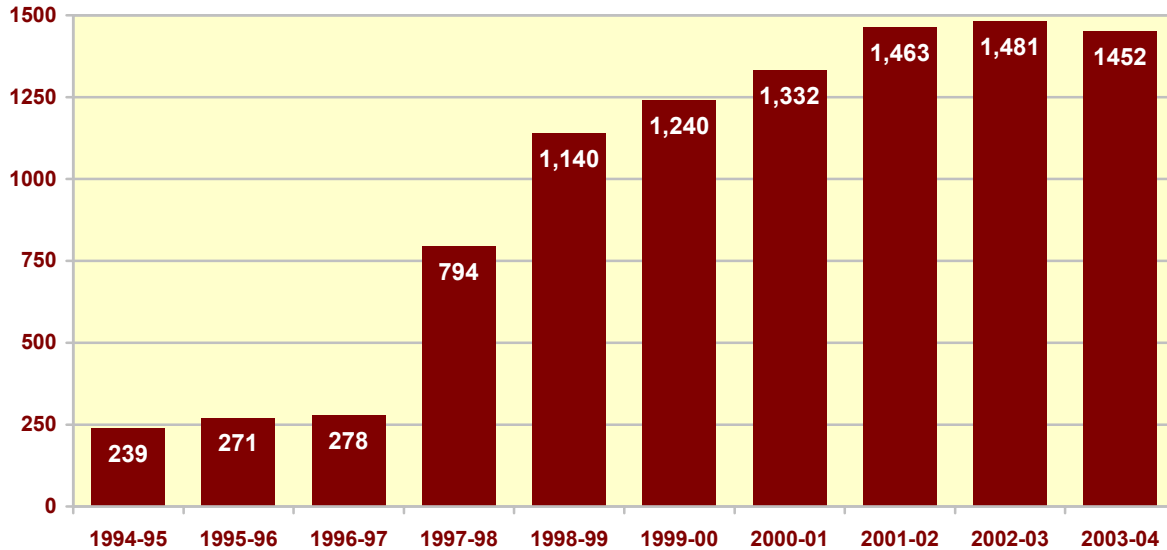

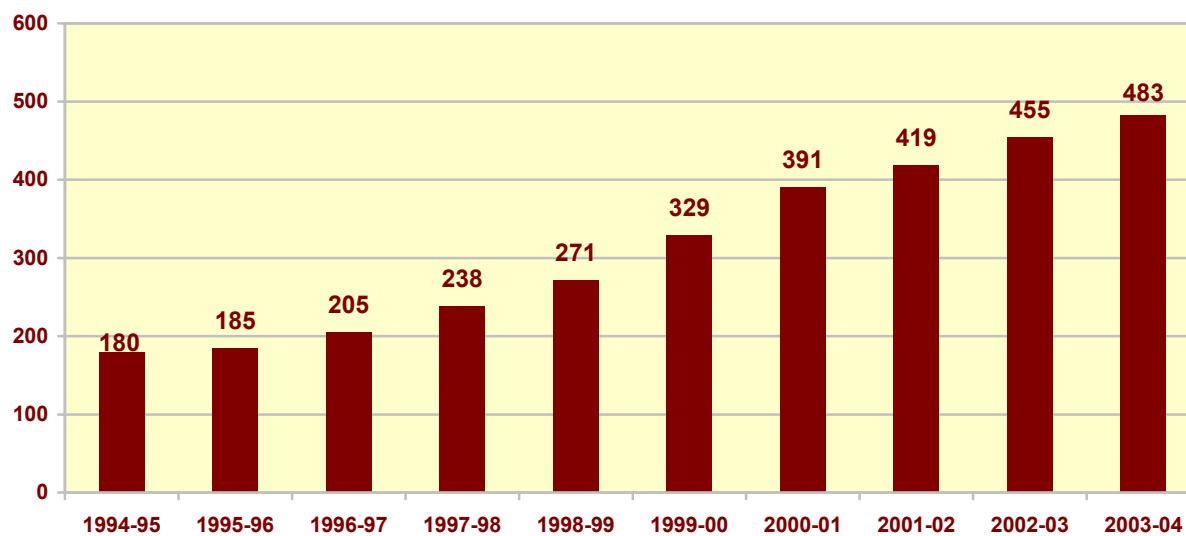

*"Other" States Enrollment*



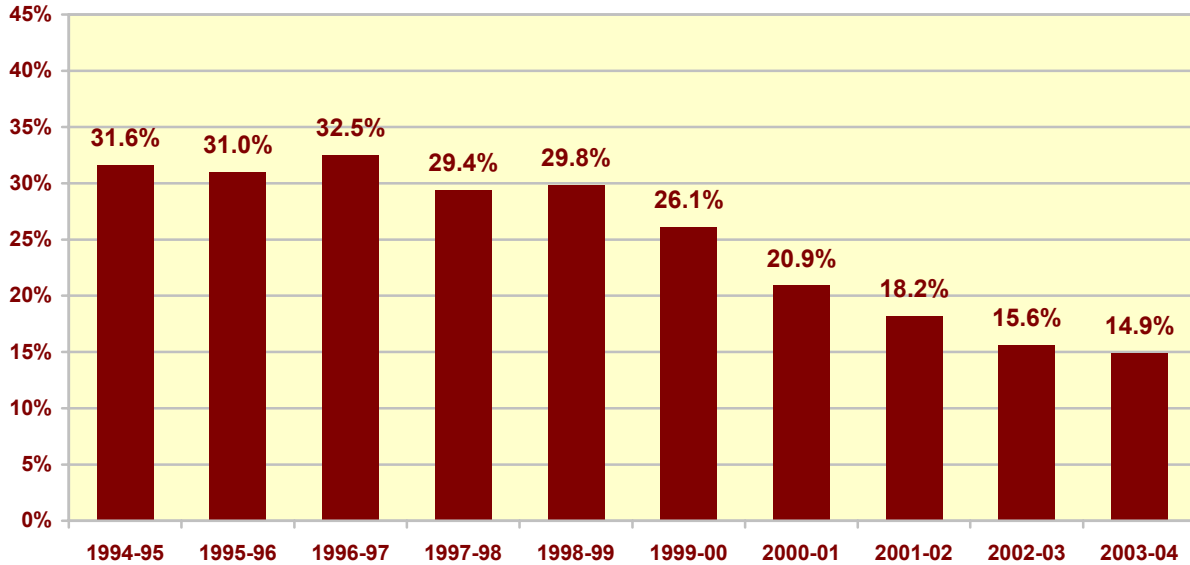

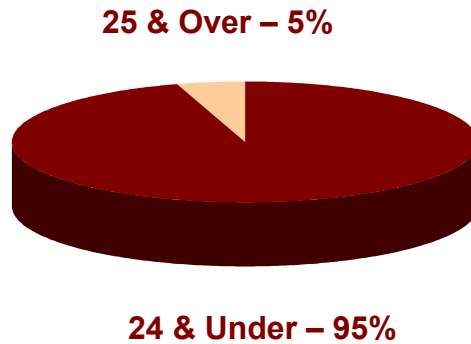

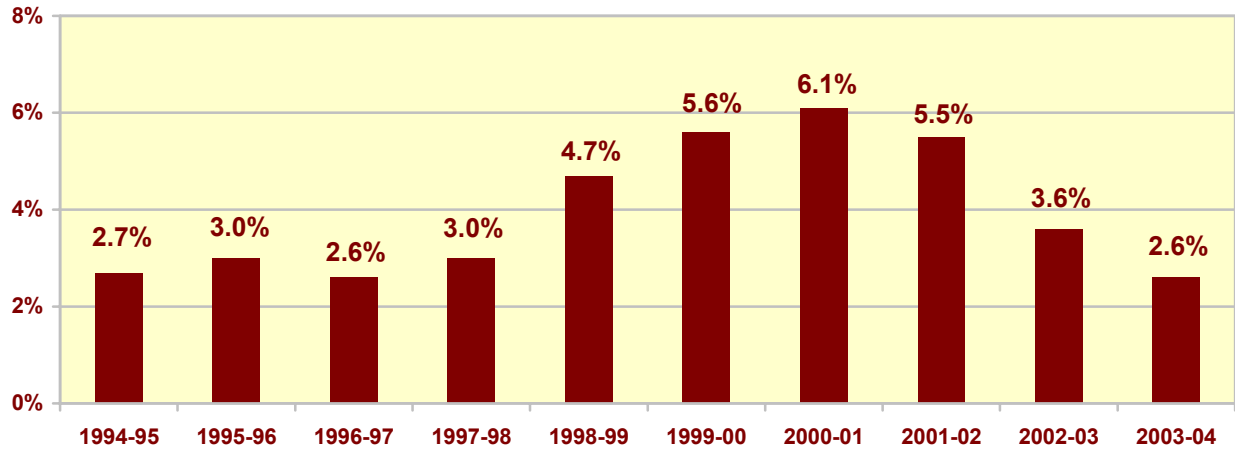

**UCC Denomination Ratio**



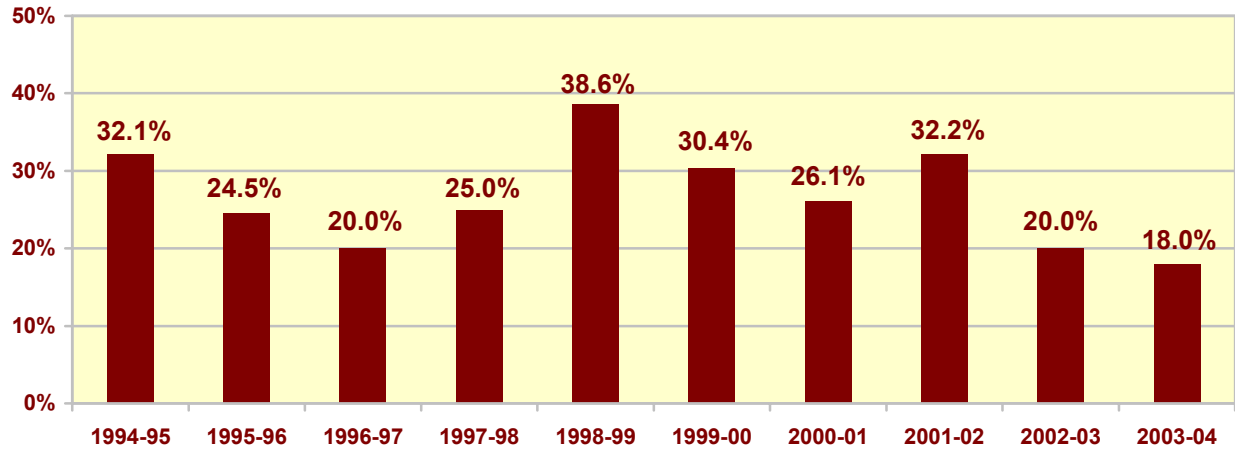

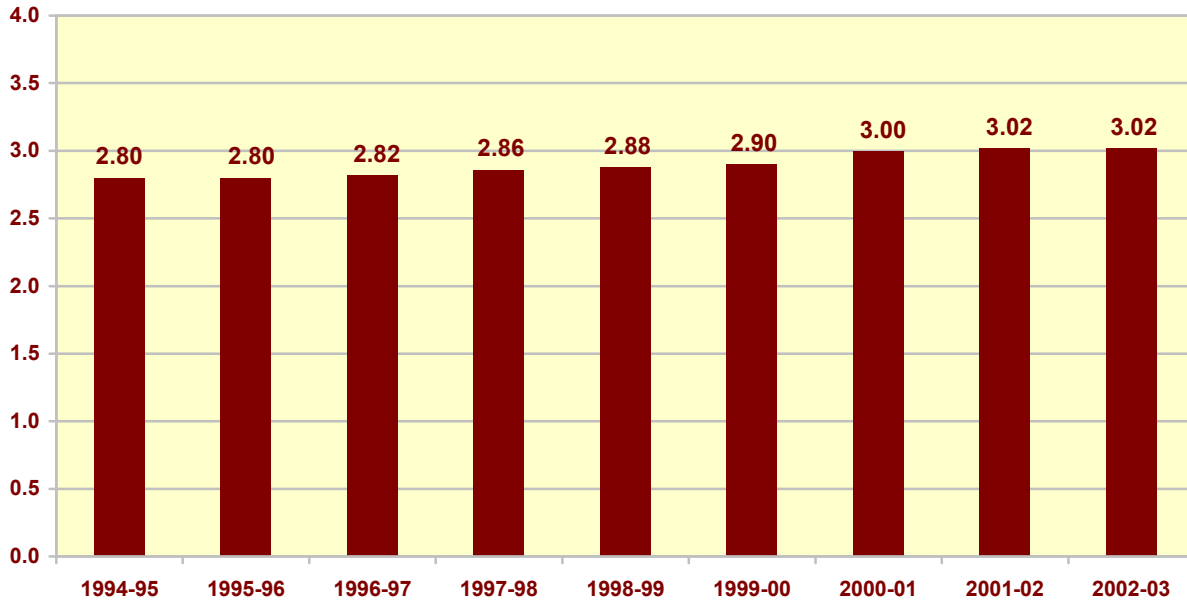

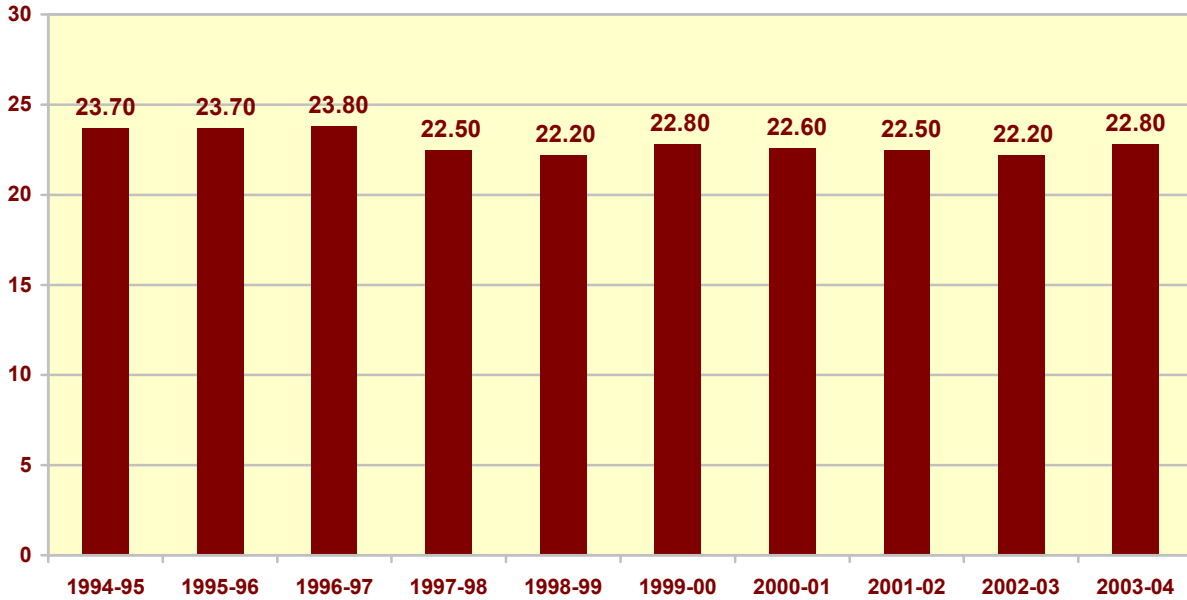

*Average Class Size*

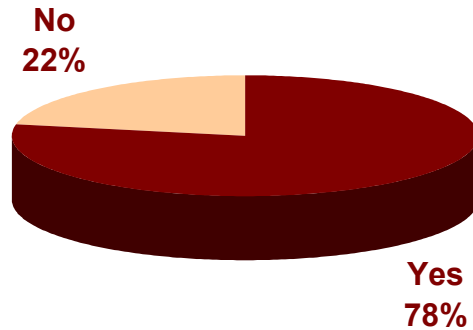

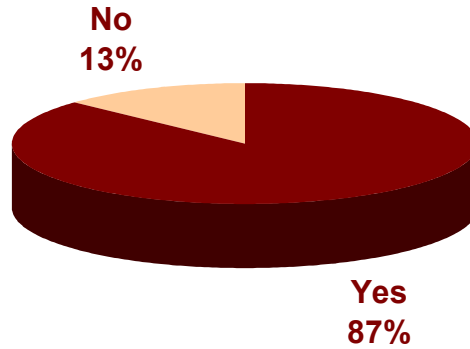

**Eighty-seven percent of students graduating in 2002-03 engaged in some form of volunteer or service activity.**



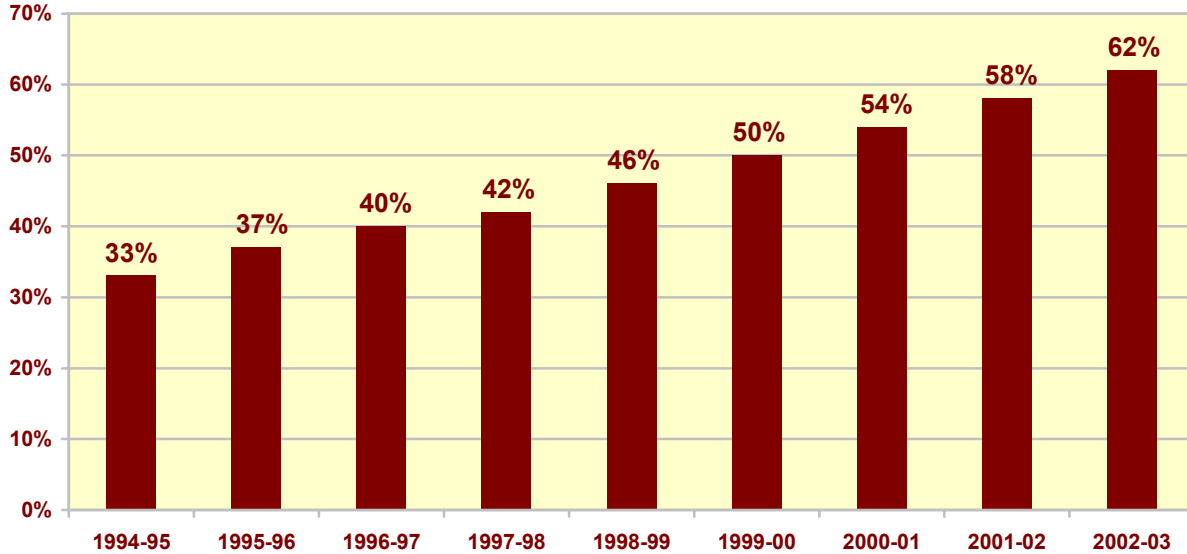
