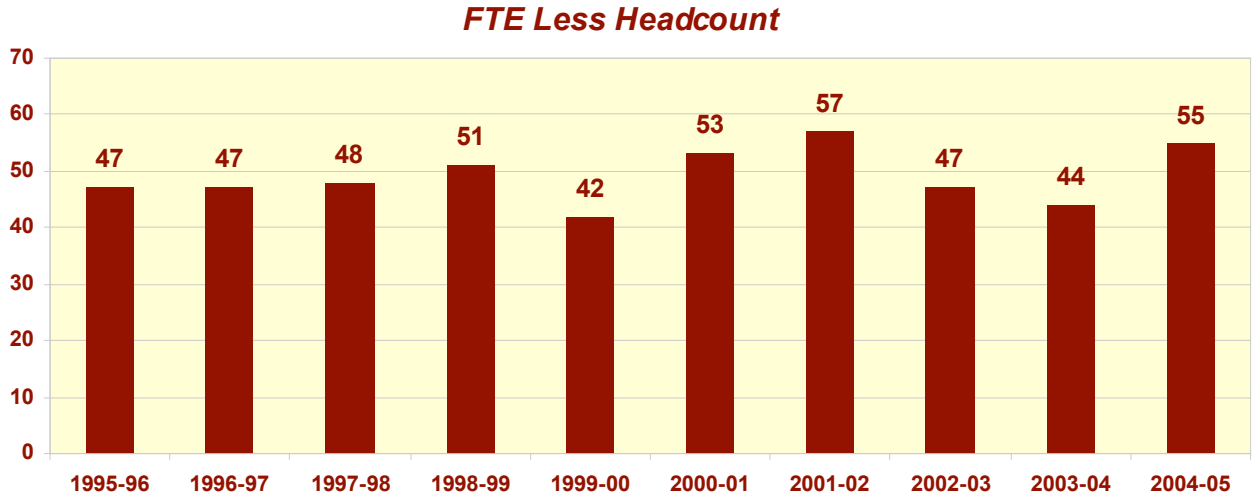

In 2004-05 Elon added 9 new full time faculty. The difference between full time faculty and FTE faculty increased from 44 to 55.

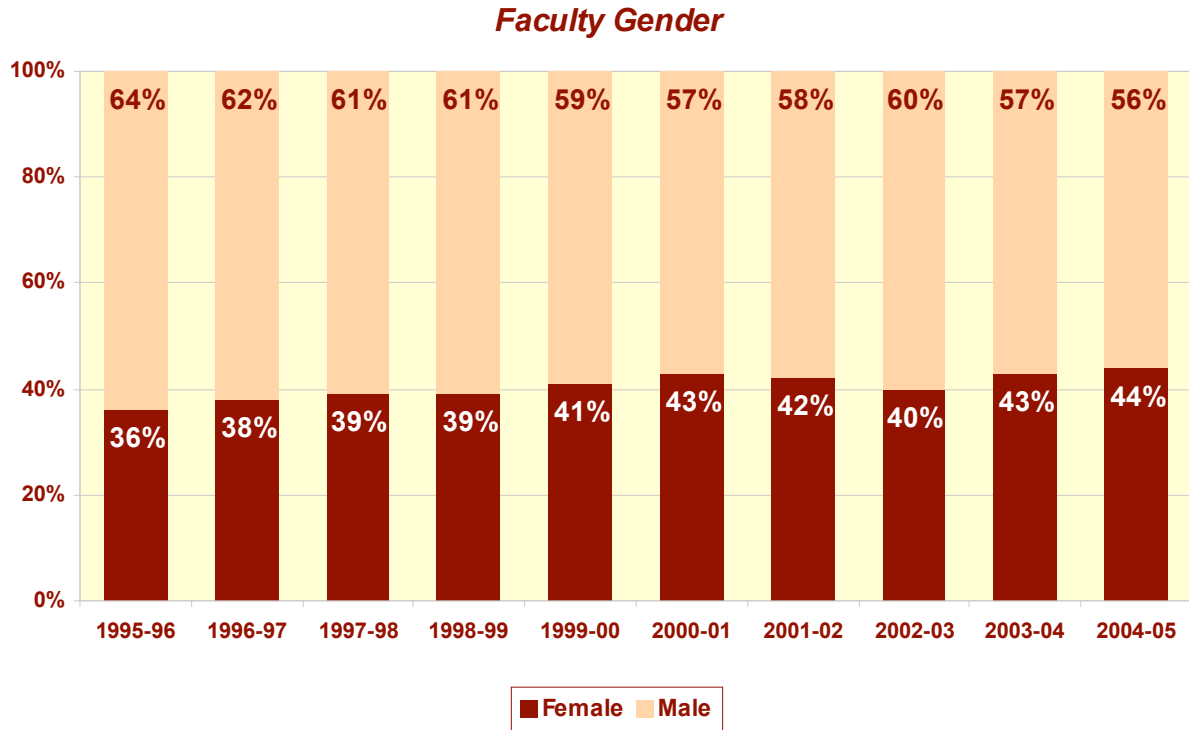

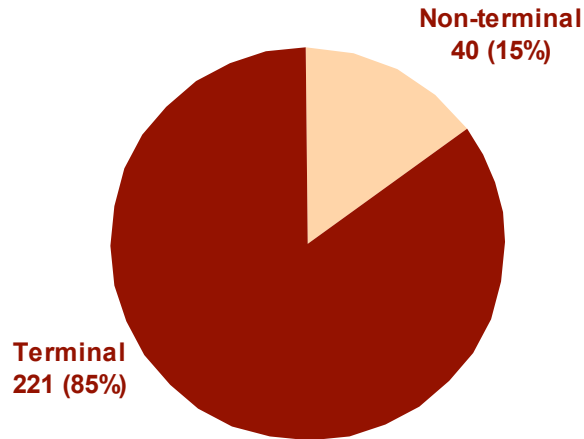

2004-05 Faculty with a Terminal Degree

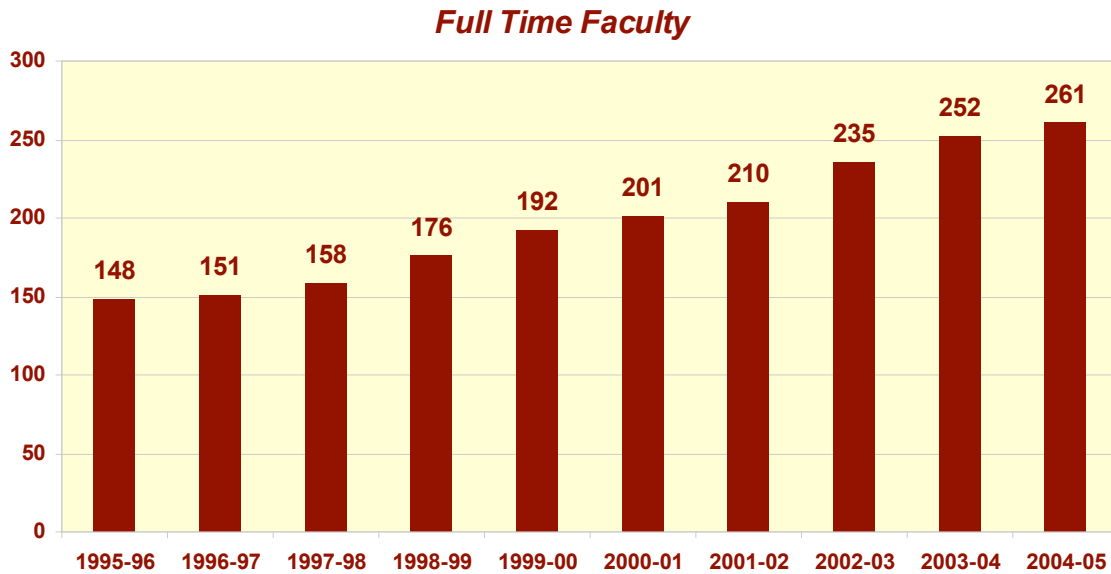

Total full time faculty by rank is shown in the table below.

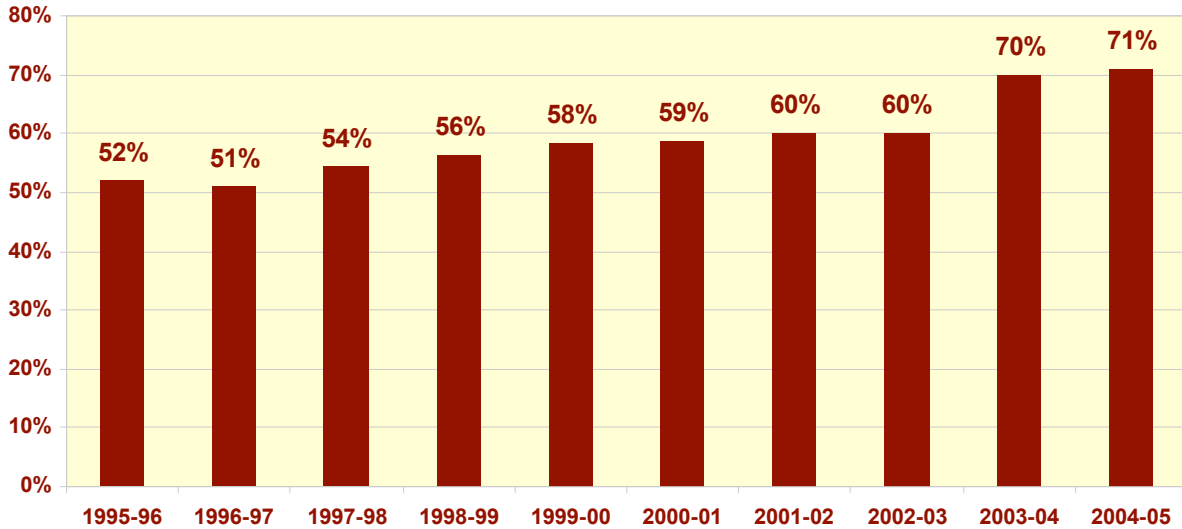

Tenured/Non-tenured Faculty

Percent of Faculty Tenured/Tenure Track



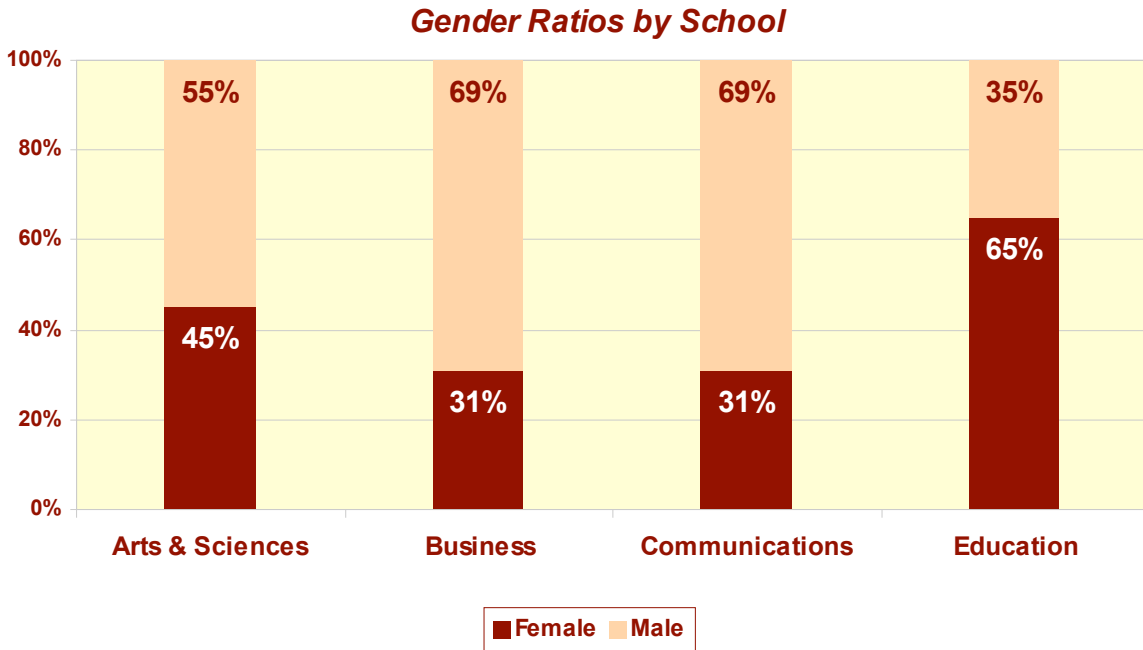

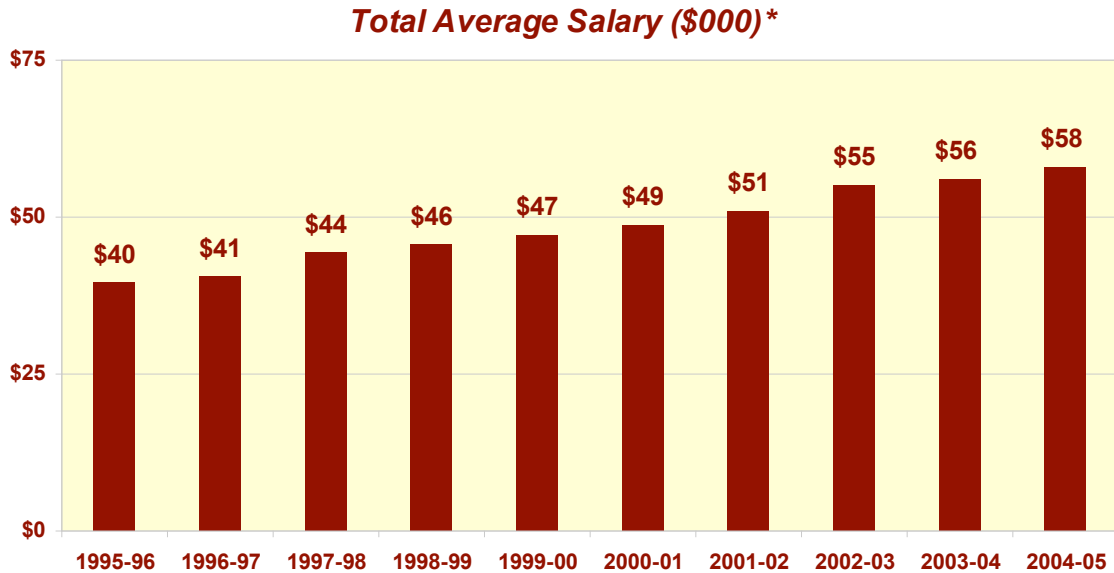
