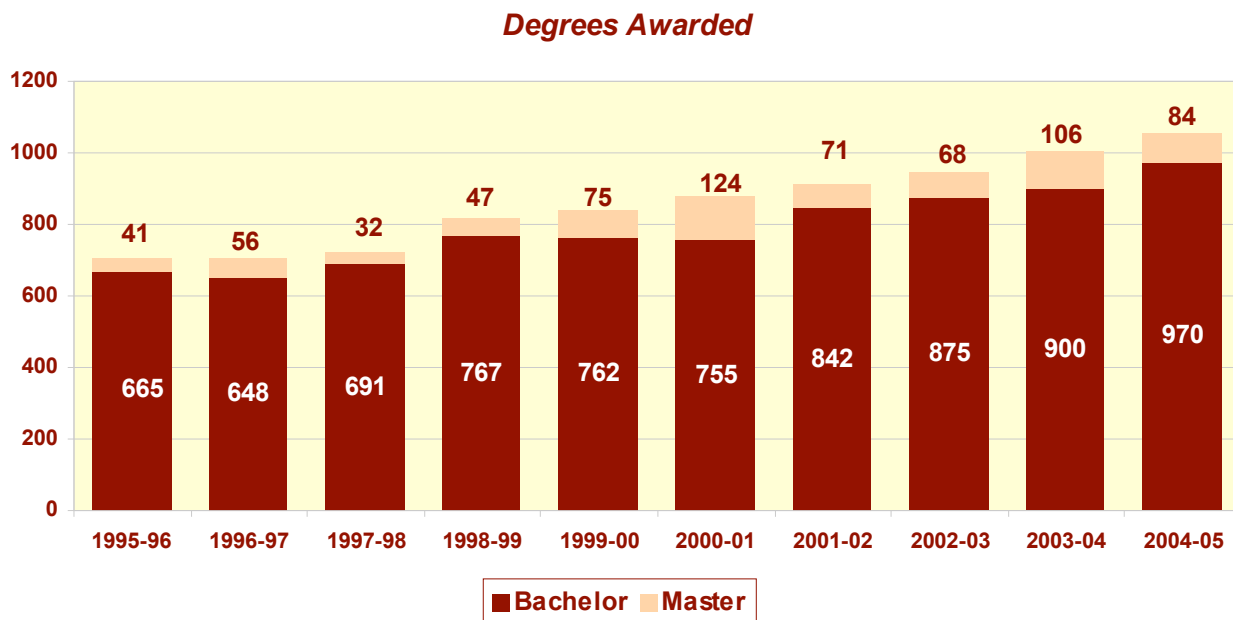

In 2003-04 Elon awarded 1,006 degrees, not including double and triple majors.



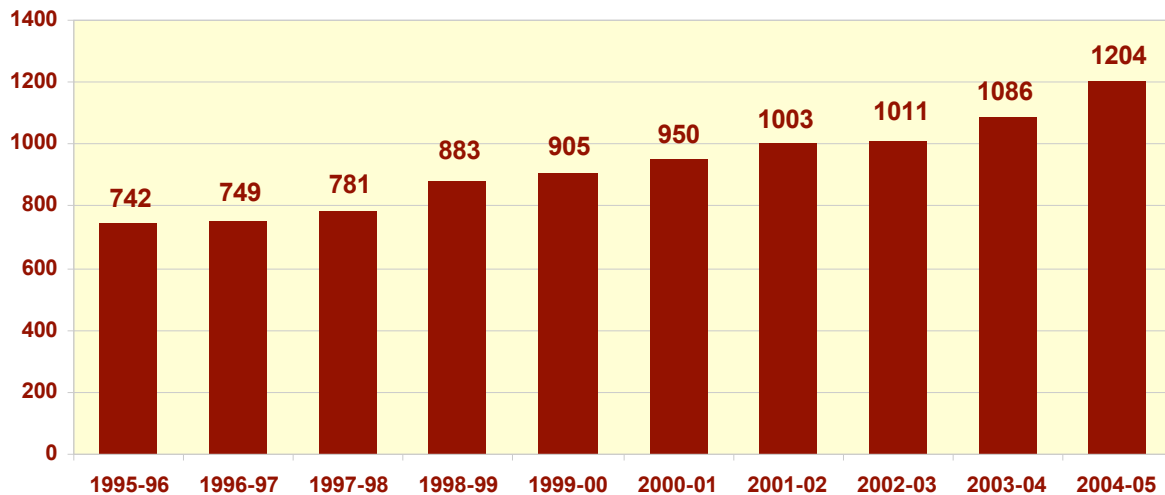

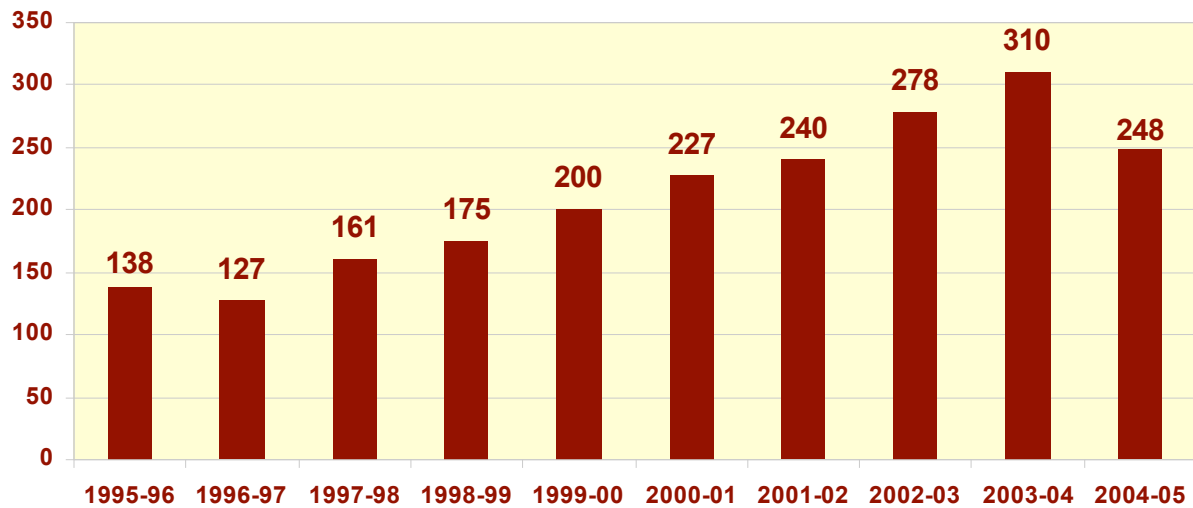

In 1891 Elon University's first graduating class consisted of 3 students. Elon's alumni currently total over 25,500.

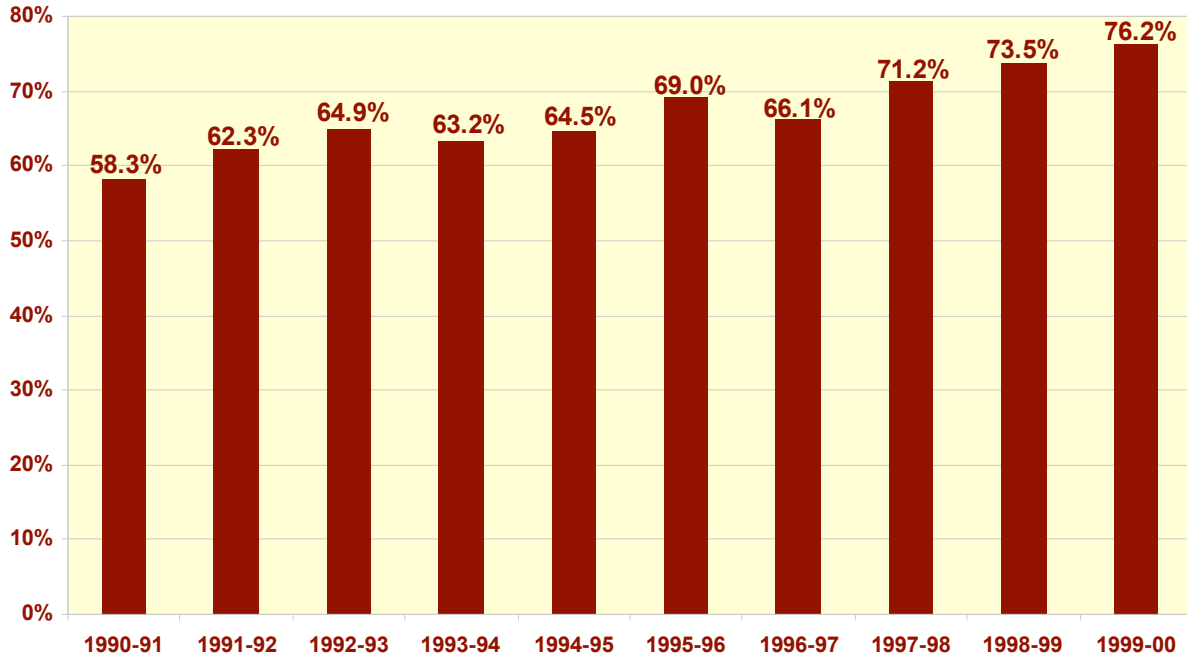

Graduation Rates

Elon's most recent six-year graduation rate is 76.2% (1999-00). The most recent five-year graduation rate is 71.8% for 2000-01. When comparing selective private institutions, the national average 5-year graduation rate is 65.4%.*

6 Year Graduation Rate



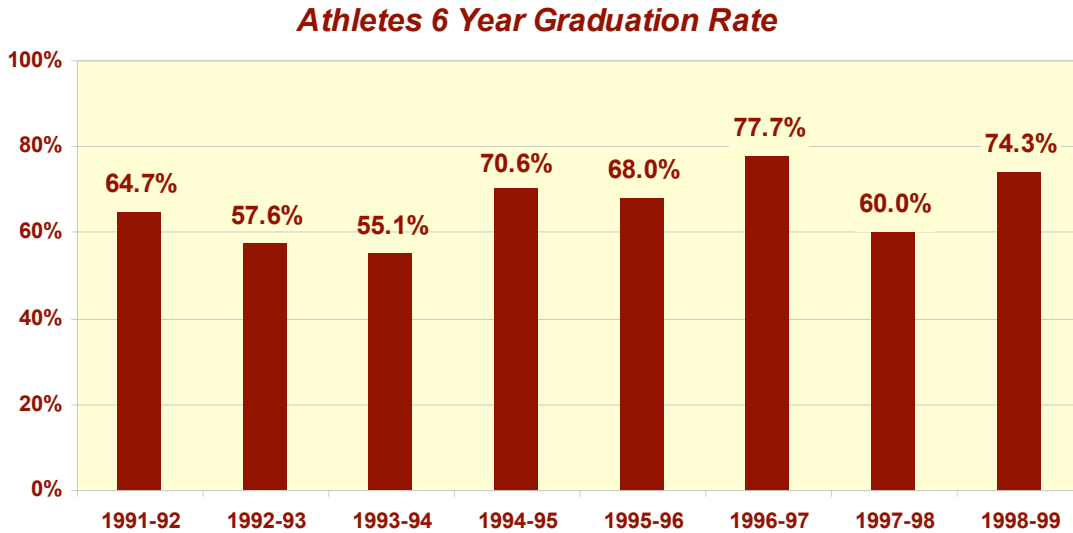
