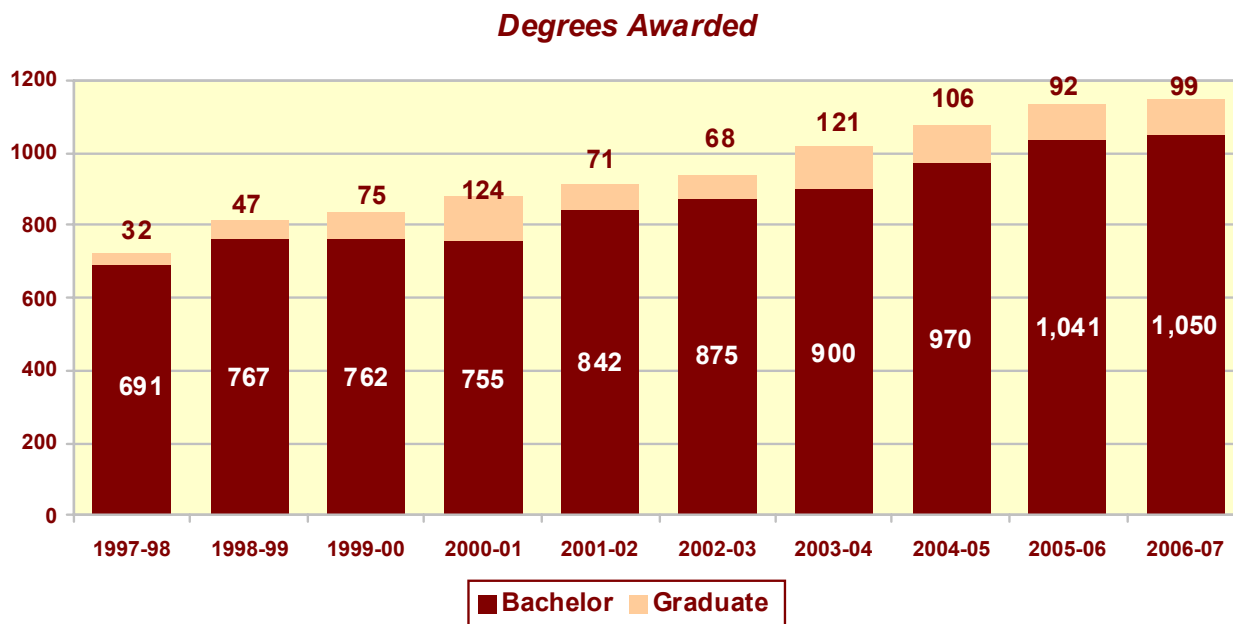

In 2006-07, Elon awarded 1,050 undergraduate degrees.



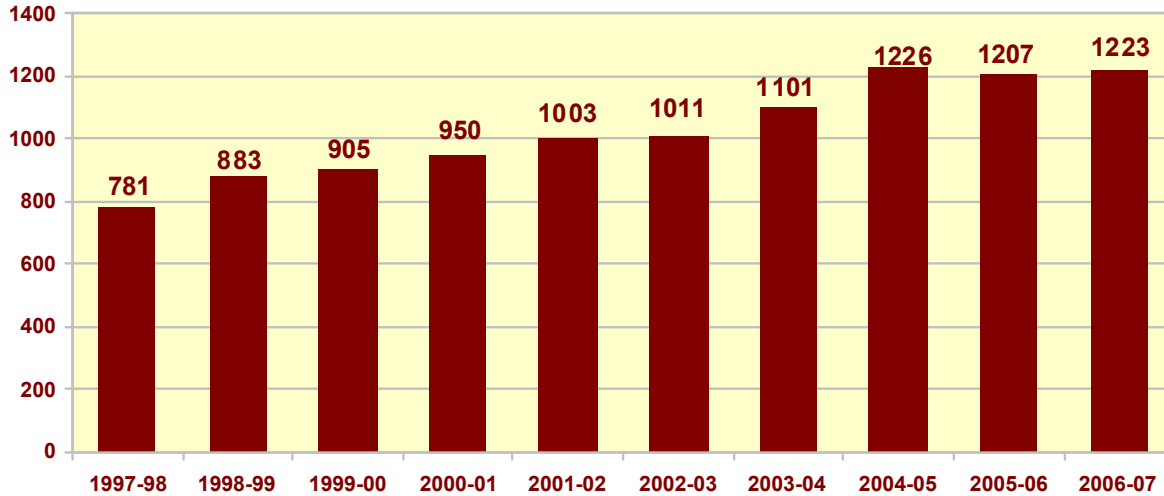

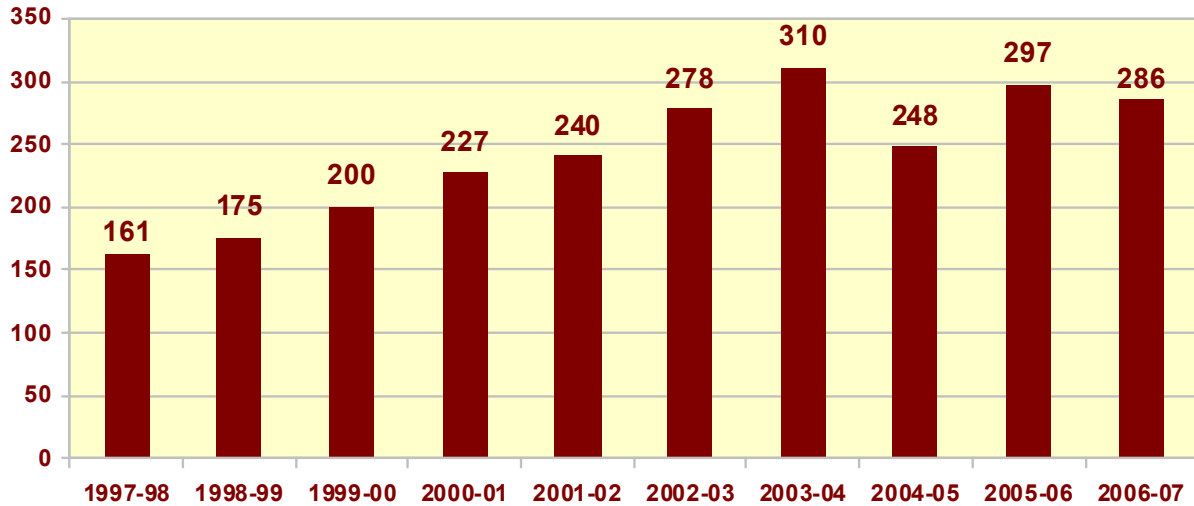

In 1891 Elon University's first graduating class consisted of 3 students. Elon has graduated approximately 28,000 students since it first began awarding degrees.

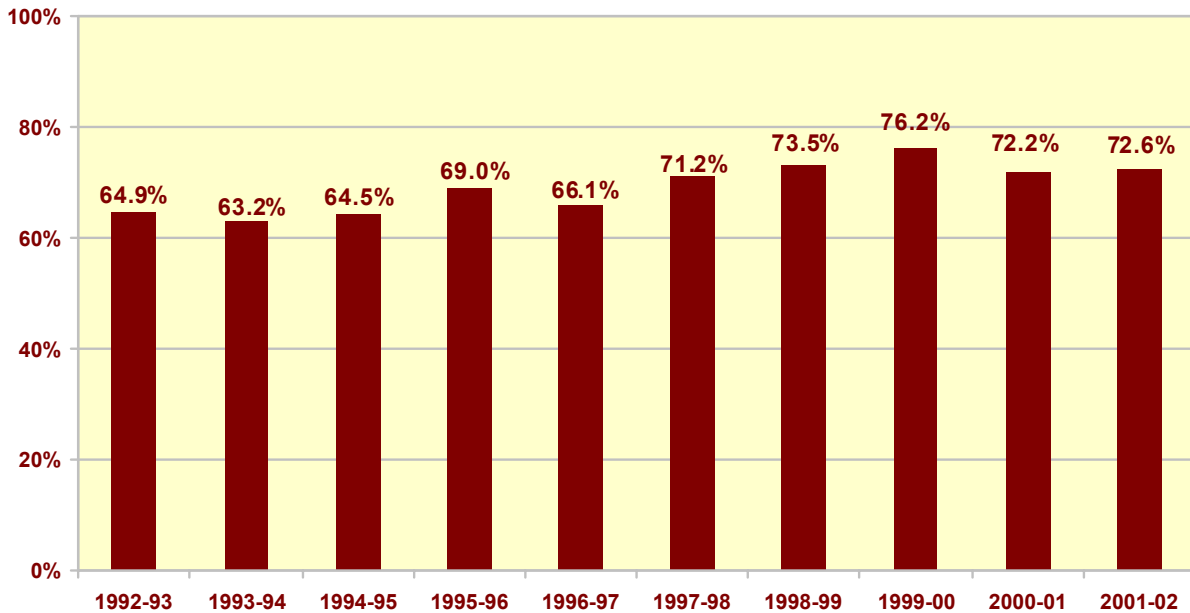

Graduation Rates

Elon's most recent six-year graduation rate is 72.6% (2001-02). The most recent five-year graduation rate is 77.8% for 2002-03. When comparing selective private institutions, the national average 5-year graduation rate is 63.9%.*

6 Year Graduation Rate



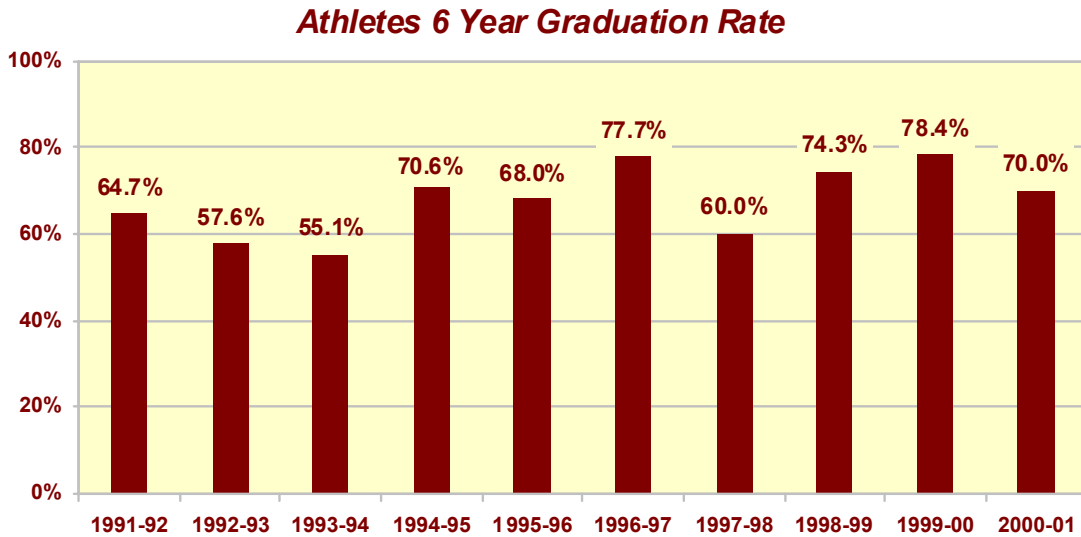

Athletic Graduation Rates

While the most recent 6-year graduation rate for athletes decreased from 78.4% to 70.0%, the athletic graduation rate tends to mirror the graduation for the entire student body.
