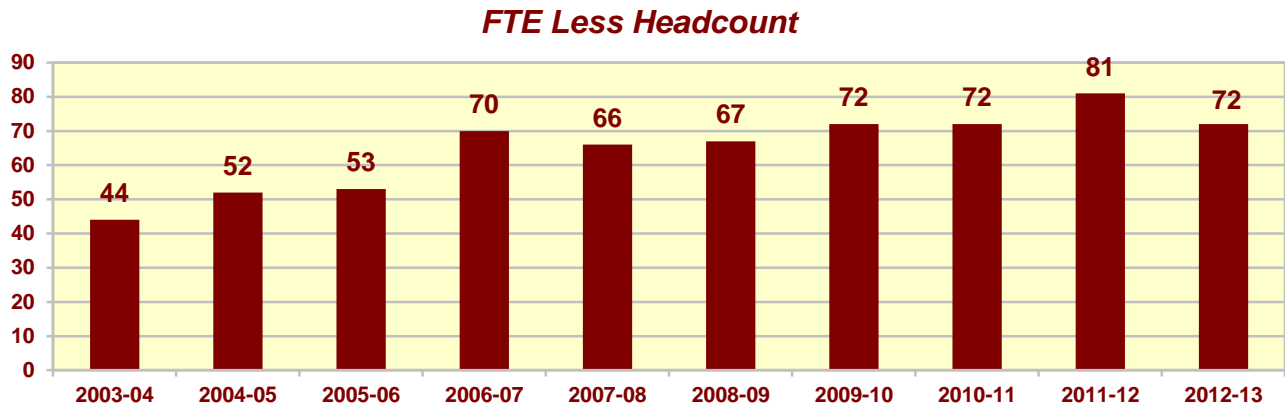

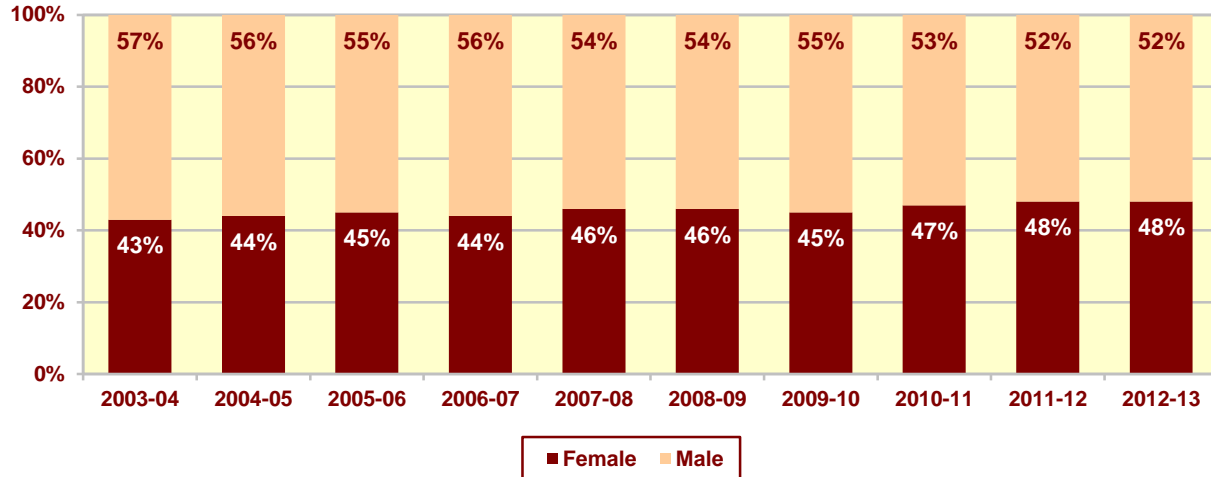

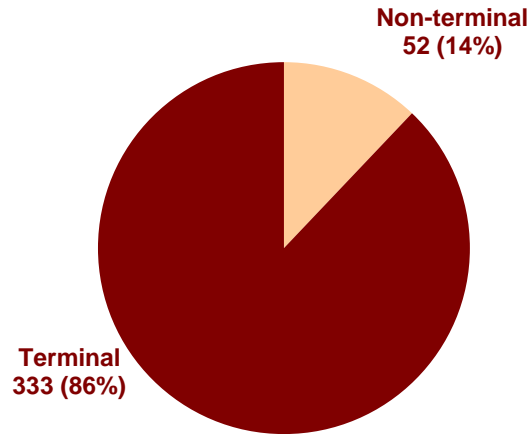

Terminal Degrees

In 2012-13, the percent of faculty that held a terminal degree is 86%. Terminal degrees include doctorate, master of fine arts (MFA), and master of social work (MSW). Nationally, approximately 68% of faculty teaching at private masters-level colleges held terminal degrees*.

2012-13 Faculty with a Terminal Degree



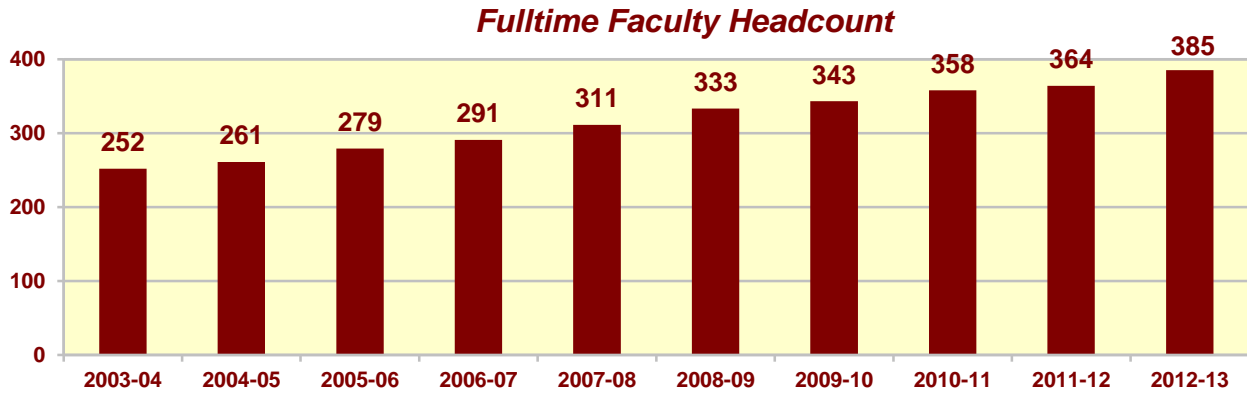

Total full time faculty by rank is shown in the table below.

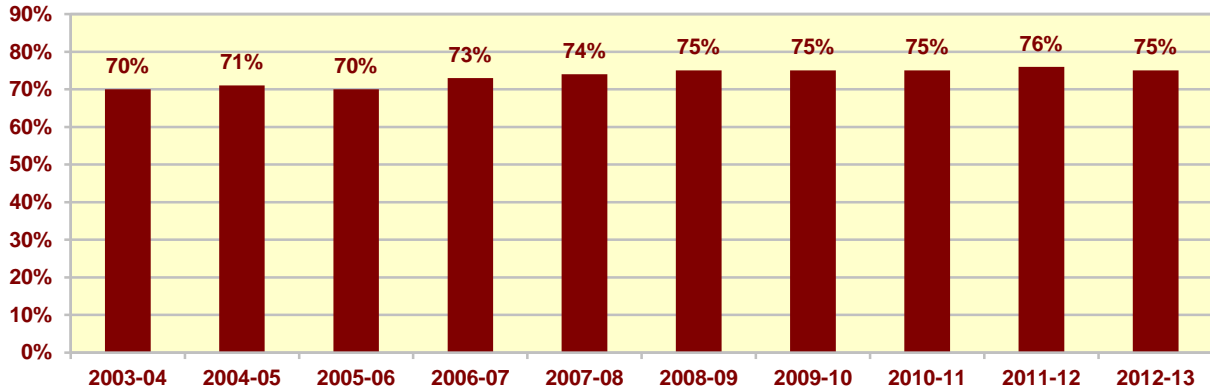

Tenured/Non-tenured Faculty

Track positions at Elon include tenure, professional, continuing, lecturer, and limited. This provides flexibility for both faculty and the institution. As indicated in the graph below most faculty (75%) were either tenured or on tenure track in the 2012-2013 academic year. Nationally at private masters-level colleges, approximately 70% of faculty are tenured or on tenure track*.

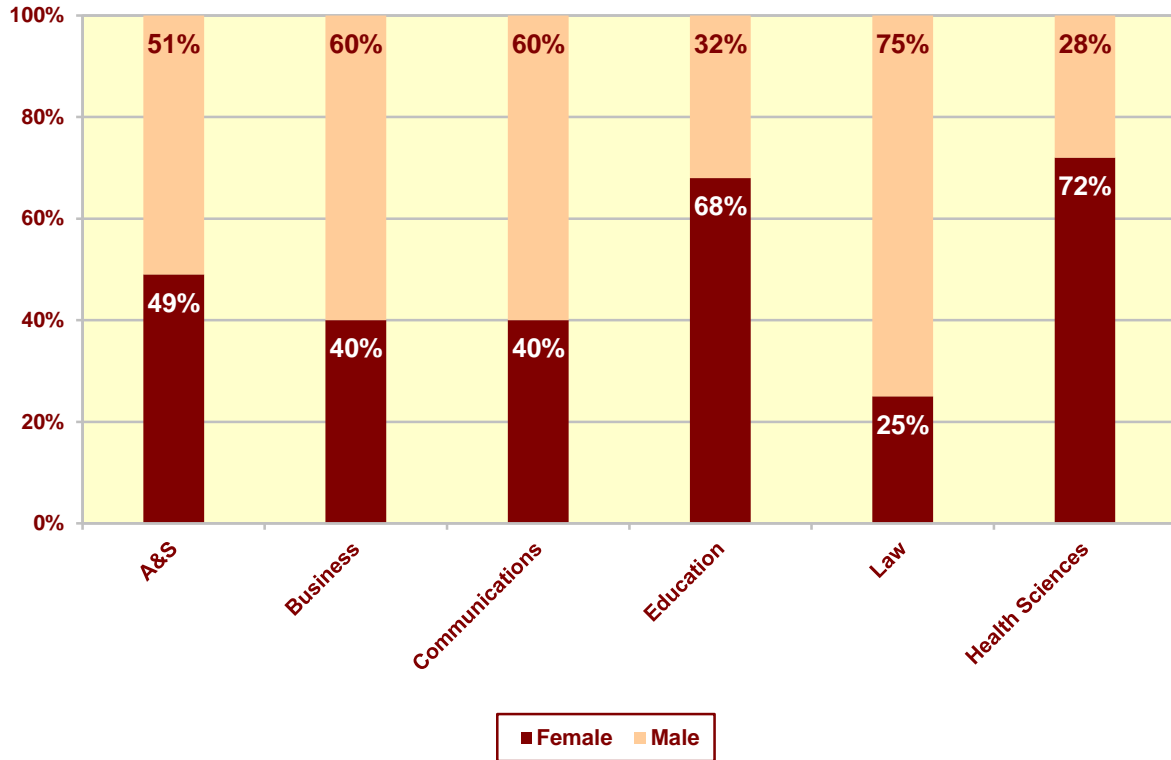

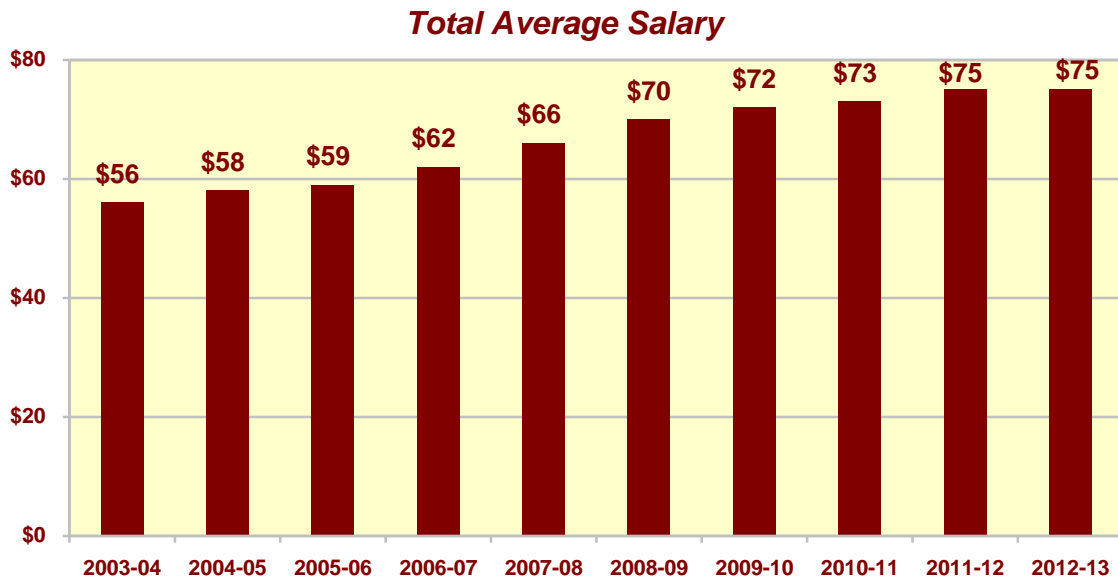
