



Certificate of Financial Responsibility

United States immigration regulations require that each student who applies for a student visa must show evidence of sufficient funds available to cover all expenses for at least one academic year. The university must have that evidence before we can issue an I-20 or DS-2019, which is required to obtain a visa. Therefore, your admissions application must include the Certificate of Financial Responsibility, as well as a bank statement (or a letter from your sponsor's bank) dated within six months of the start of the first semester at Elon showing the amount of funds available. If your sponsor is not your parent or yourself, please include a brief letter from your sponsor stating the relation and his/her intent to support all your expenses during your time at Elon University.

The total cost for one academic year (two semesters) at Elon University is \$54,949.
