



Please share your opinions with young people from the global-good project [Imagining the Internet](http://www.imaginingtheinternet.org) at IGF 2016 in Guadalajara, Mexico

You are invited to visit with a team of **Elon University** students who are asking IGF participants to share their thoughts about the Internet in brief video interviews.

Imagining the Internet is a Webby Award-winning, non-profit, civil society project. We ask people to share their views in order to expose issues and potential impacts, to inform policy, and to create a public record that tells the story of the Internet's evolution.

You will be asked these questions:

Who are you? (Your name, work title/affiliation, the country in which you live, and your IGF stakeholder group.)

1) What is next for the Internet? – VERY briefly share what you think the next big thing in the Internet's evolution will be. What is emerging now in regard to new technologies, applications and uses?

2) The Internet of Things and AI? The Internet of Things and artificial intelligence are deploying algorithms across the world to augment human abilities and knowledge. How will the IoT and AI improve life; how are they also disrupting things?

3) Key Internet issues today? What are the most difficult Internet challenges, fears or issues that must be addressed to assure the best future for all?

4) Action? What action or actions should be taken now to assure the best possible future? How can people make things better and which organizations need to lead?

5) Access? Access is a primary goal of IGF. How will bringing another billion people globally online change the world?

6) Anything you want to add? & What is the future of the Internet in a nutshell? What question do you wish we had asked – and how would you answer it? And... In just 1 to 10 words – in 5 seconds or less, describe the Net's future.
