Located in the heart of downtown Greensboro, N.C., and home to the North Carolina Business Court, Elon Law is the nation's preeminent school for engaged and experiential learning in law. Students engage the legal profession in meaningful ways through their residencies, first-year lab courses, attorney shadowing, five law clinics, trial and appellate advocacy, moot court and mock trial programs, and team-based legal projects for nonprofits and public agencies, reflecting the school's full integration of experiential education in its curriculum.
