

2015-2016 Priorities and Accomplishments

1. Continue our efforts to better communicate across campus to hear about campus climate issues as well as test ideas to improve the campus climate. (We conducted a series of interviews with students, faculty and staff about their experiences at Elon and used their responses to inform our work for next year. We hosted a number of visitors in ICC from diversity centers across campus).
2. Launch an anti-bias communications campaign (We partnered with Live Oak Communications to create a strategy for this priority and are continuing our work with them in the fall. Also, the LGBTQIA task force and the CREDE both created inclusive language and terminology awareness campaigns).
3. Establish community dinners (T.J. Bowie, coordinator for Residential Dining and Engagement, began this tradition and will continue it next year).
4. Monitor progress on LGBTQIA, Black Communities and Title IX task forces. (We received updates on each of these efforts that will all continue into next year).
